- VII. Financial Services Report Mr. Michael Armstrong
 - A. March Monthly Statements

March 2022 highlights included total unrestricted revenue of \$11,456,547, which is 80.47% of the total budget of \$14,235,550. Total unrestricted expenses of \$9,126,128, which is 64.11% of the total budget of \$14,235,550. Total revenues over expenditures at March 31, 2022 were \$2,330,419. Total cash and investments at March 31, 2022, were \$9,129,611.48.

B. April Monthly Statements

April 2022 highlights included total unrestricted revenue of \$12,712,545, which is 88.91% of the total budget of 14,297,979. Total unrestricted expenses of \$10,038,134, which is 70.21% of the total budget of \$14,297,979. Total revenues over expenditures at April 30, 2022 were \$2,674,410. Total cash and investments at April 30, 2022, were \$9,330,586.57.

 - 1. Forestry Program SouthArk has received funding from the State to launch a new Forestry Program. Also, the Mahony family has designated funds for a new endowed scholarship in their name for this program.
 - 2. Medium and Heavy Truck Training Program (Diesel Tech) With funding from the State, SouthArk is to launch a new Transportation Technology Center on the East Campus. The Industrial Tech Building is to be remodeled/renovated to accommodate the new Medium and Heavy Truck Training Program.
 - 3. NISOD /Award SouthArk has been selected as a "2022 Most Promising Places to Work in Community Colleges" (MPPWCC) Award Winner. The NISOD Award is being awarded to SouthArk as being the best-in-class student and staff recruitment and retention practices, inclusive learning and working environments, and meaningful community service and engagement opportunities. Dr. Bentley Wallace is to accept the NISOD Award on May 31st in Austin, TX.
 - 4. McWilliams House (Student Center) Update The additional outdoor space is coming together and will be an excellent area for outdoor classes and entertainment, stated Dr. Wallace.
 - 5. eSports SouthArk is moving quickly towards the launch of eSports. SouthArk has the opportunity to partner with the Murphy Arts District (MAD) to hold a large regional eSports competition this fall.
 - 6. Project Management System SouthArk will be looking into developing a more sophisticated system for tracking large projects and managing timelines and deadlines. Currently, SouthArk has at least 23 large projects open.
 - 7. Dr. Derek Moore (VPSS) Dr. Moore will be leaving SouthArk at the end of June to accept the presidency in New Mexico. (organizational restructuring will be occurring in the Student Services Department)
 - 8. Occupational Therapy Assistant Program (OTA) The SouthArk OTA program is officially closed as is no longer a program at SouthArk.
 - 9. Legislative Audit The auditors will be on campus next Monday and are to be stationed at SouthArk for a couple of months.
 - 10. Open Board Seat Mr. David Fox, CEO of the Medical Center of South Arkansas, has applied for the "Open Board Seat" at SouthArk.
 - 11. Men's Basketball Coach Mr. Cameron Robinson has been hired as the new men's basketball coach.
 - 12. El Dorado Conference Center (ECC) Marketing Ms. Caroline Callaway has been hired as the head of marketing for the ECC.
