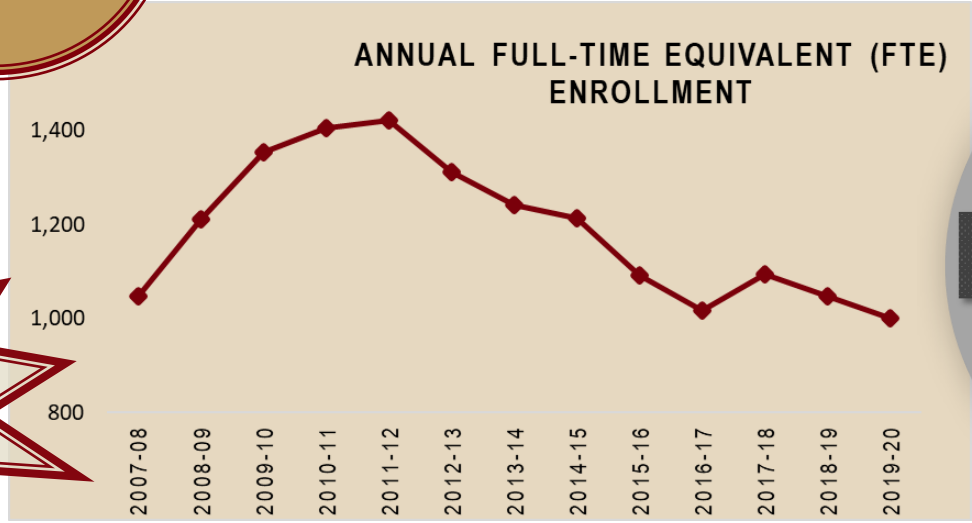


SouthArk's Average Student to Faculty Ratio is 15:1

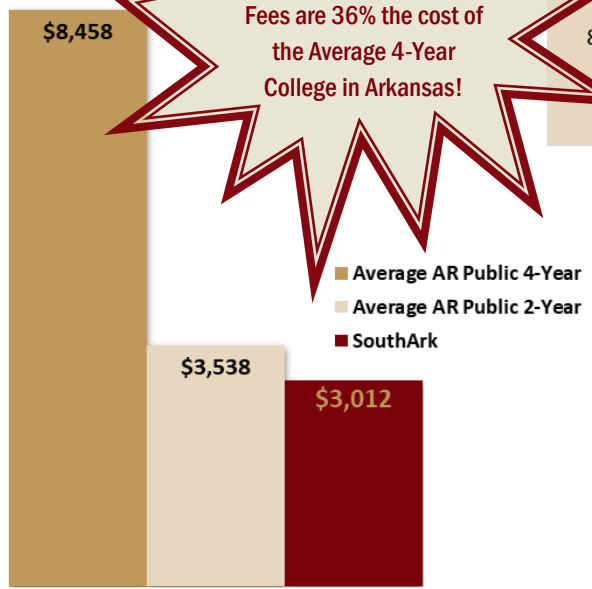
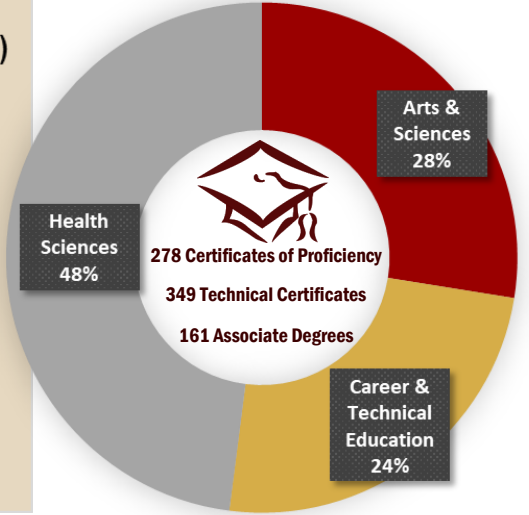
SouthArk has over 20 Transfer Agreements with 4-Year Universities

2019-2020 Graduates

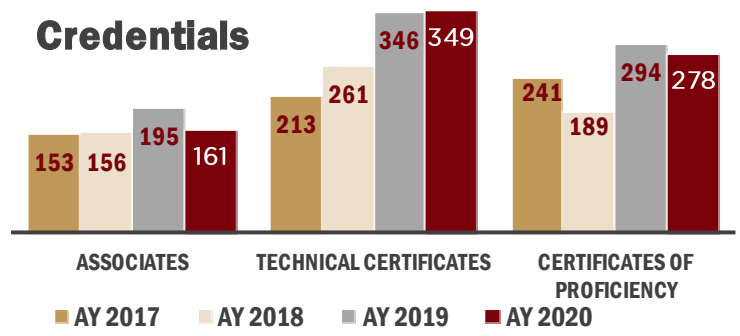


SouthArk's Tuition and Fees are 36% the cost of the Average 4-Year College in Arkansas!
