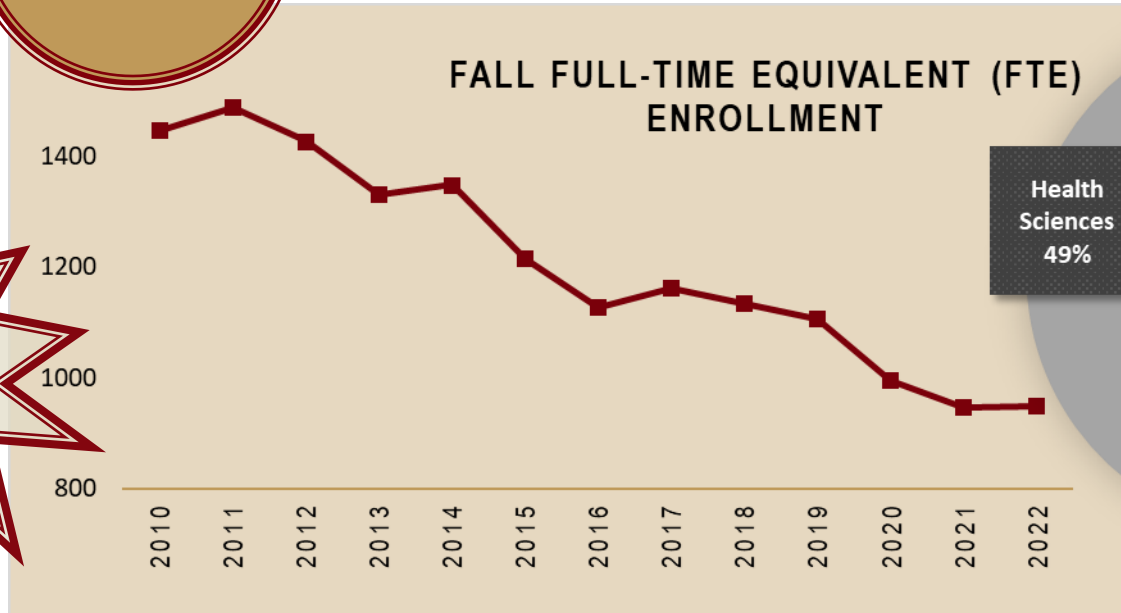
SouthArk's Average Student to Faculty Ratio is 13:1

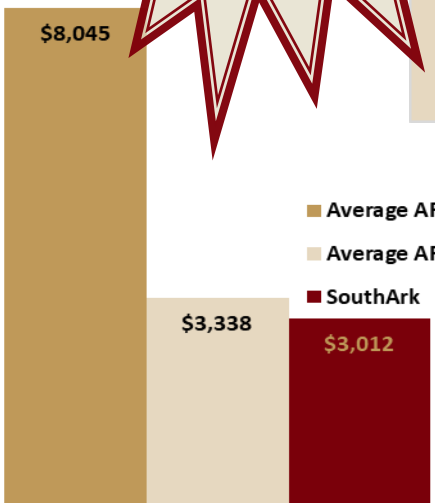
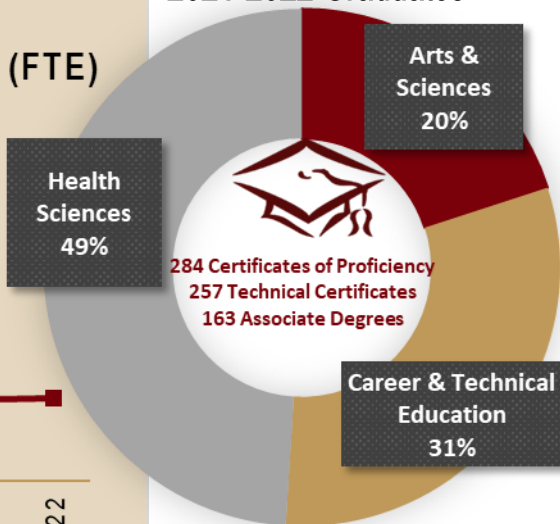

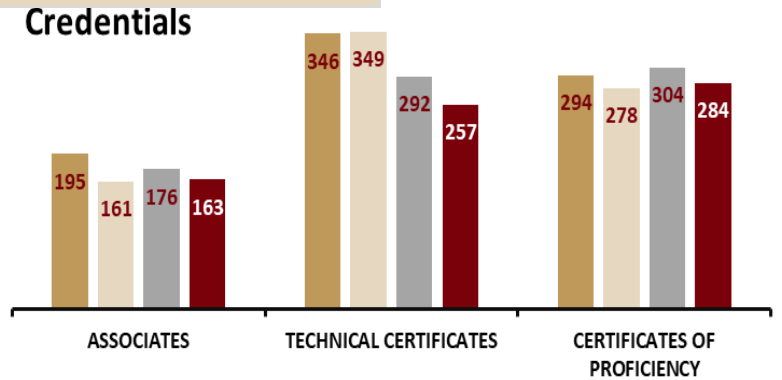
2021-2022 Graduates
