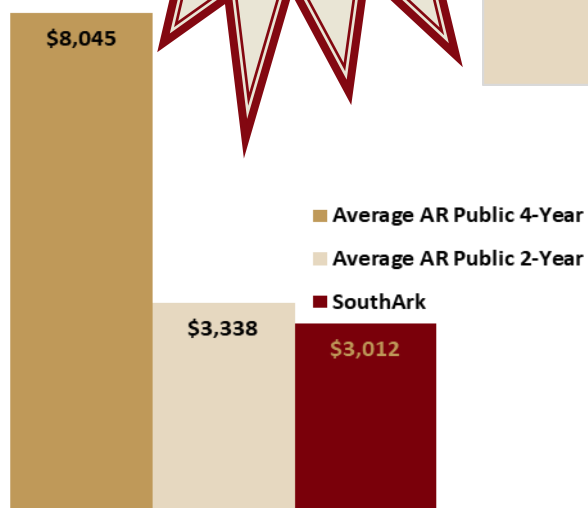
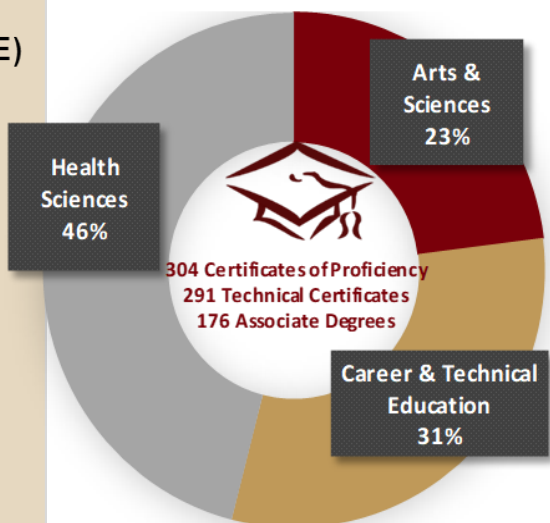
SouthArk has over 20 Transfer Agreements with 4-Year Universities

### 2020-2021 Graduates

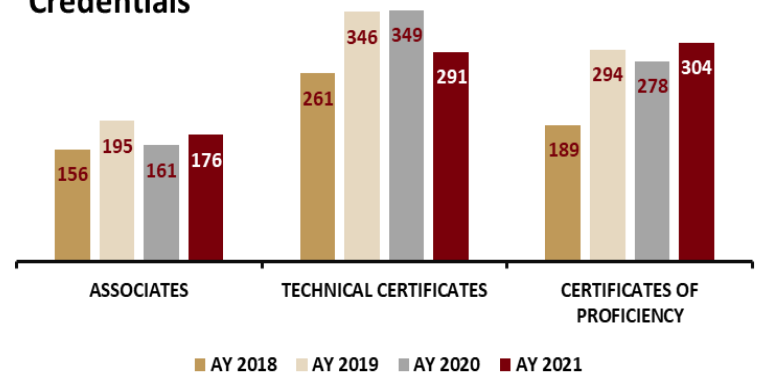
