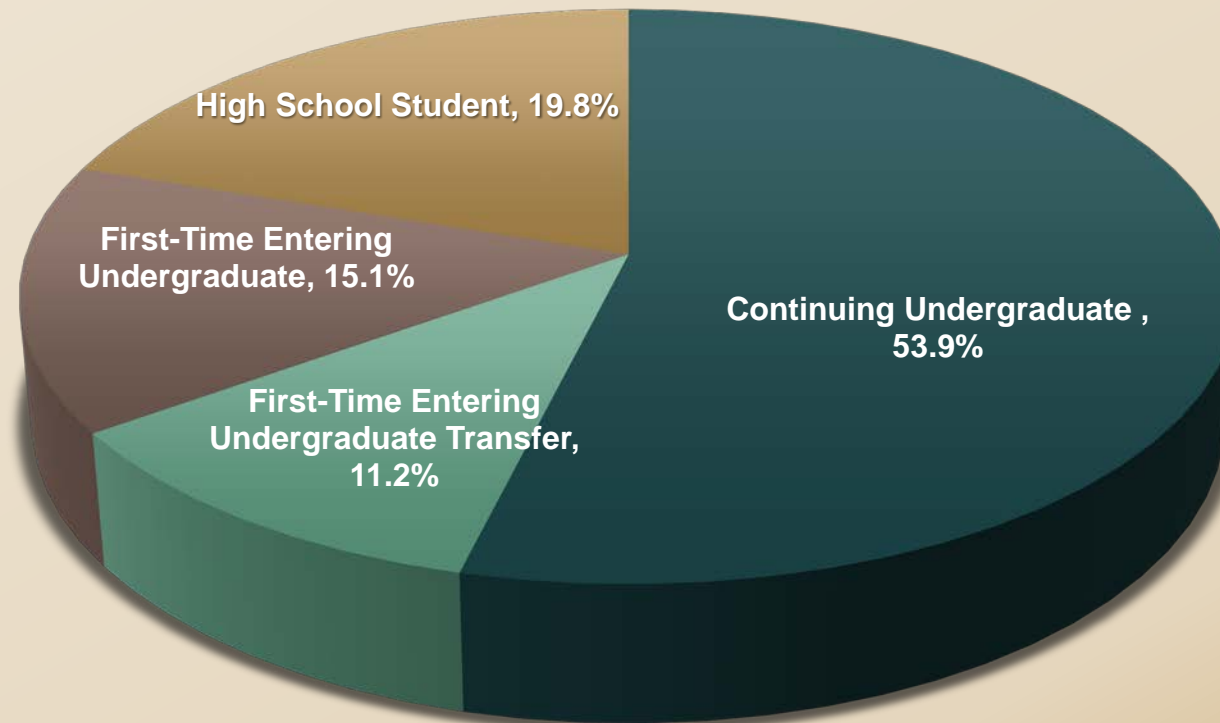
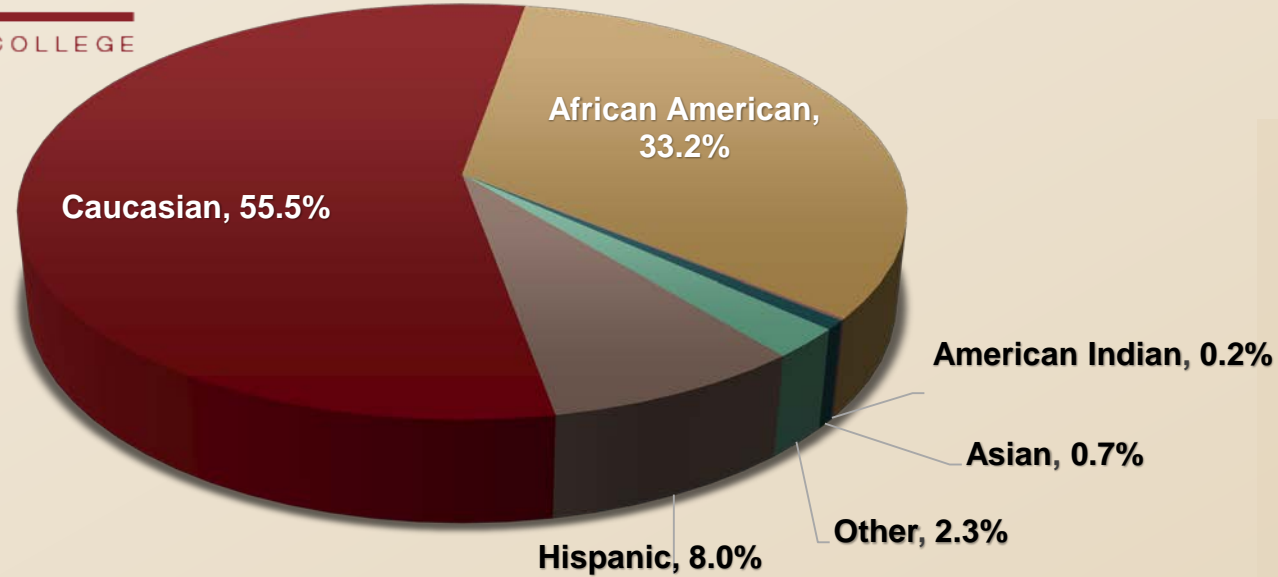


CLASSIFICATION OF ENROLLMENTS FALL 2020

ENROLLMENT BY ETHNICITY FALL 2020



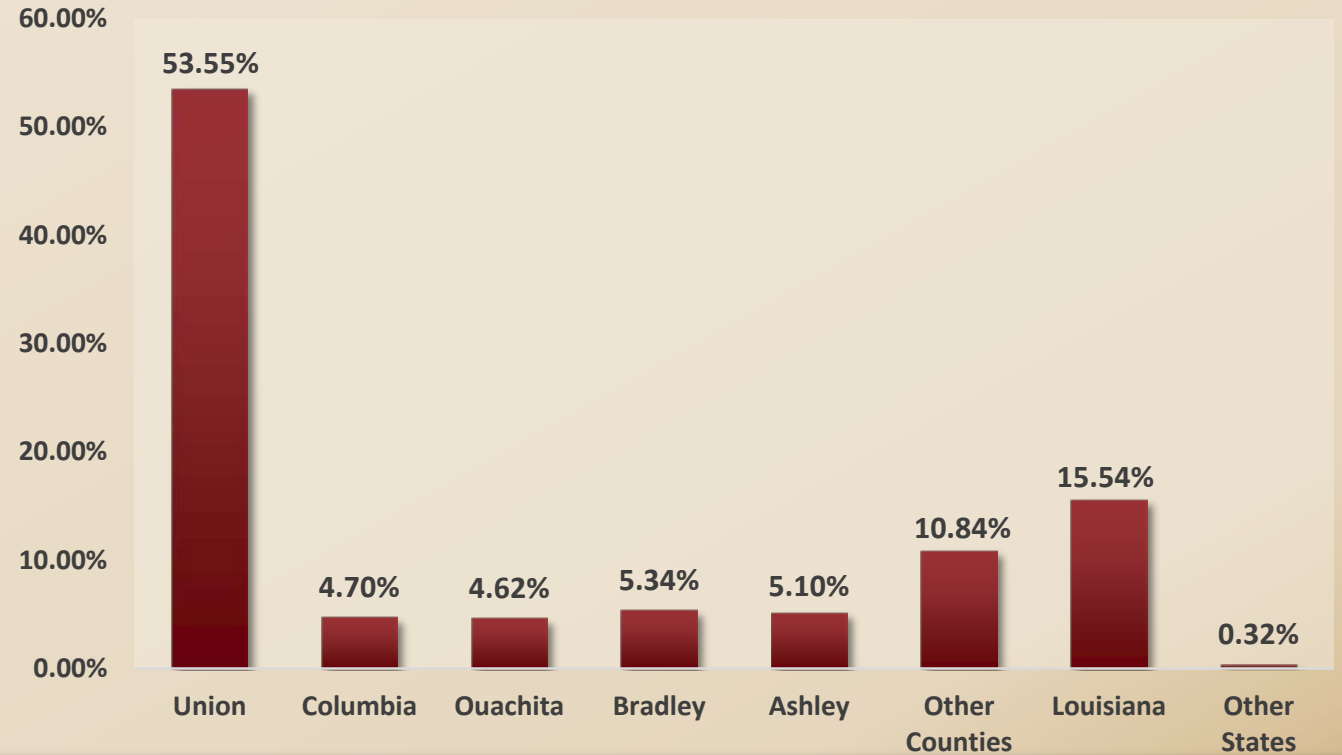

While SouthArk's service area is defined as Ashley, Bradley, Chicot, and Union counties, our students come from all over the region.

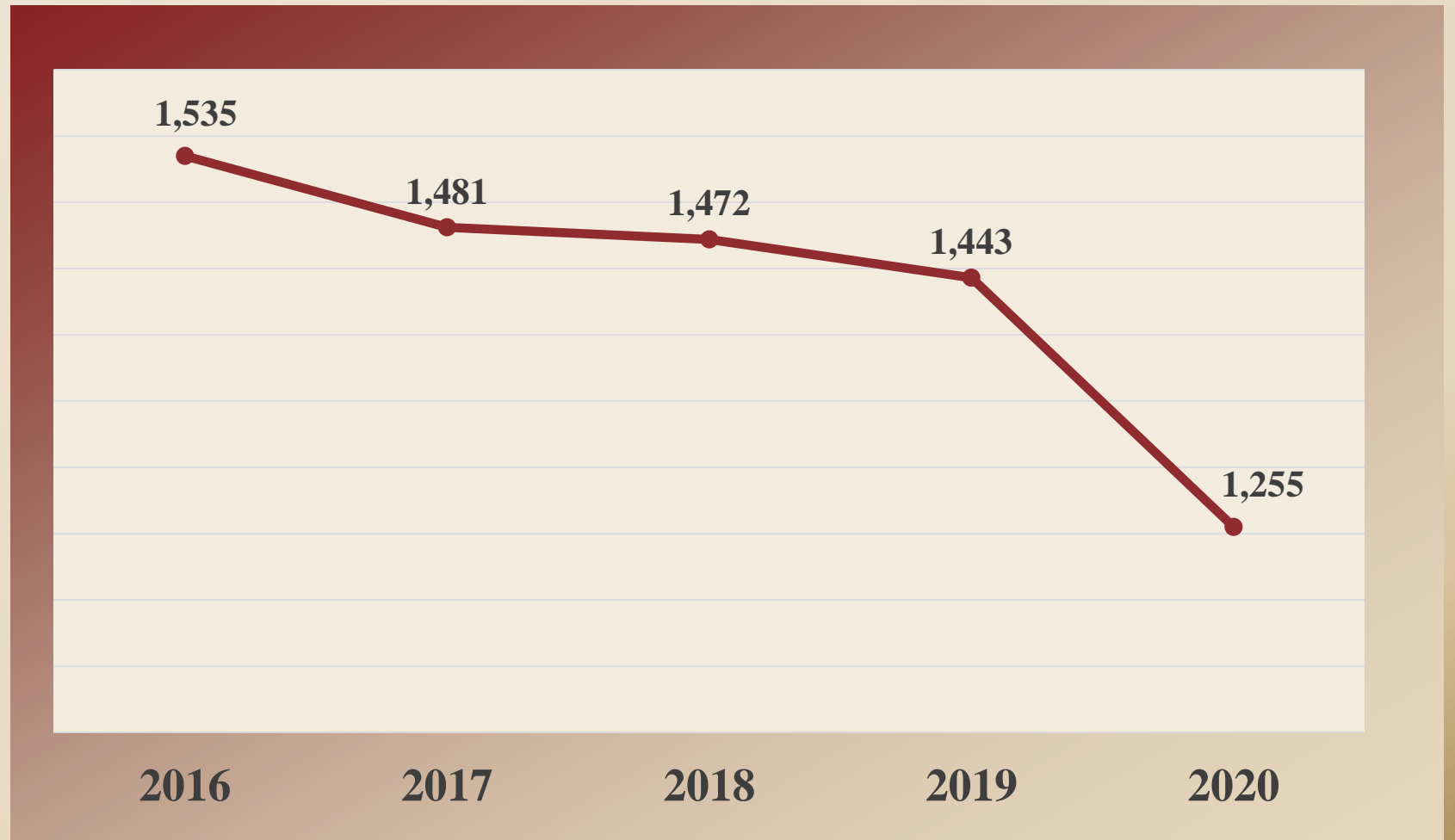

ENROLLMENT BY FALL 2016-2020

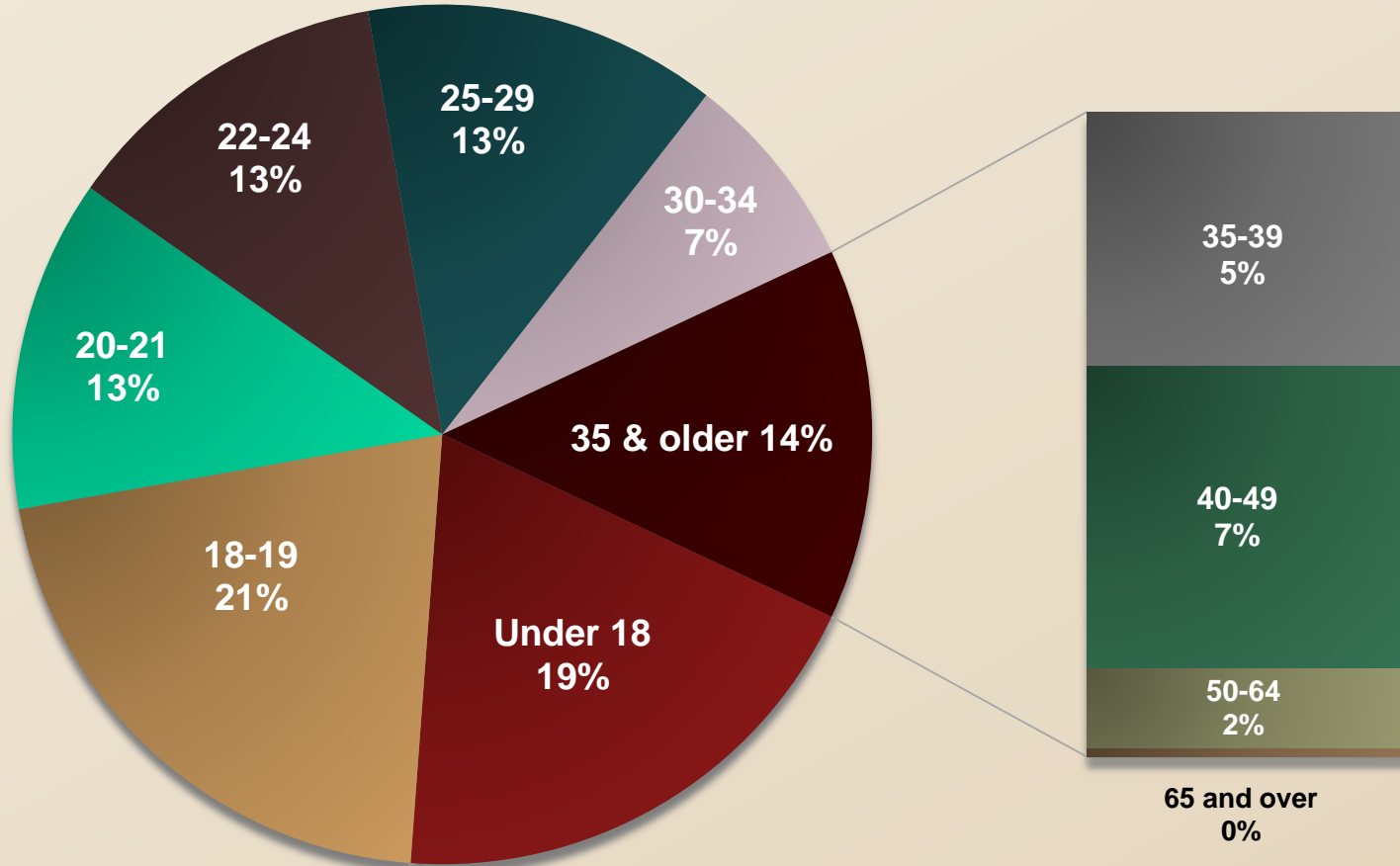

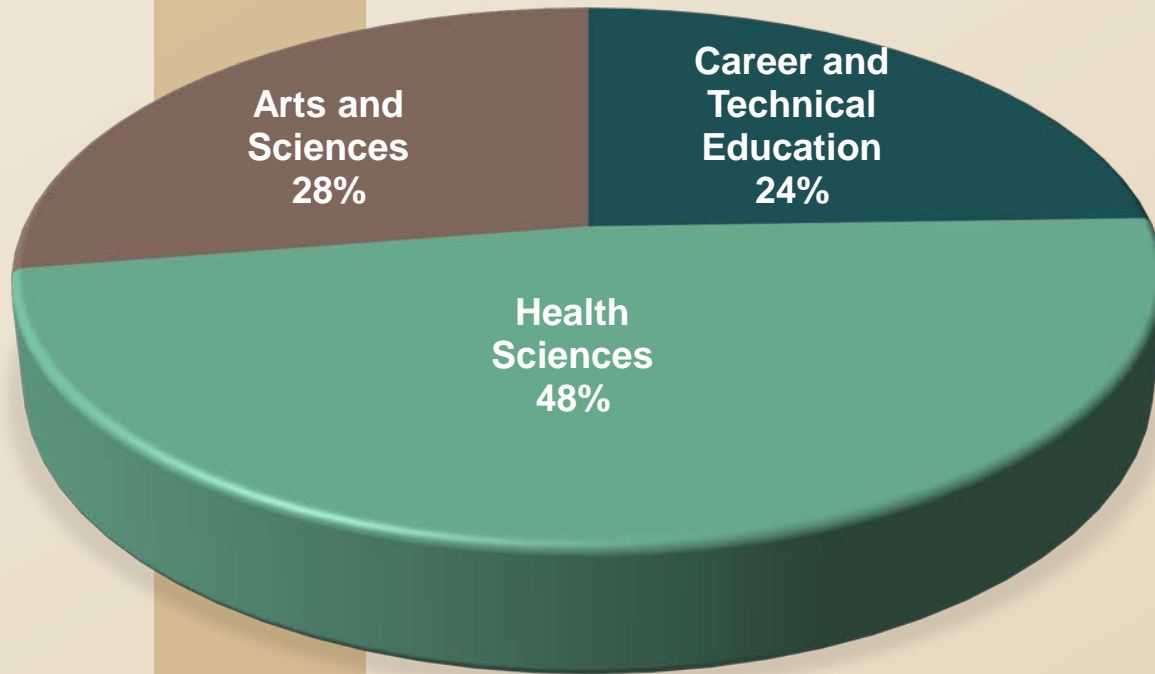
AGE OF ENROLLMENTS FALL 2020

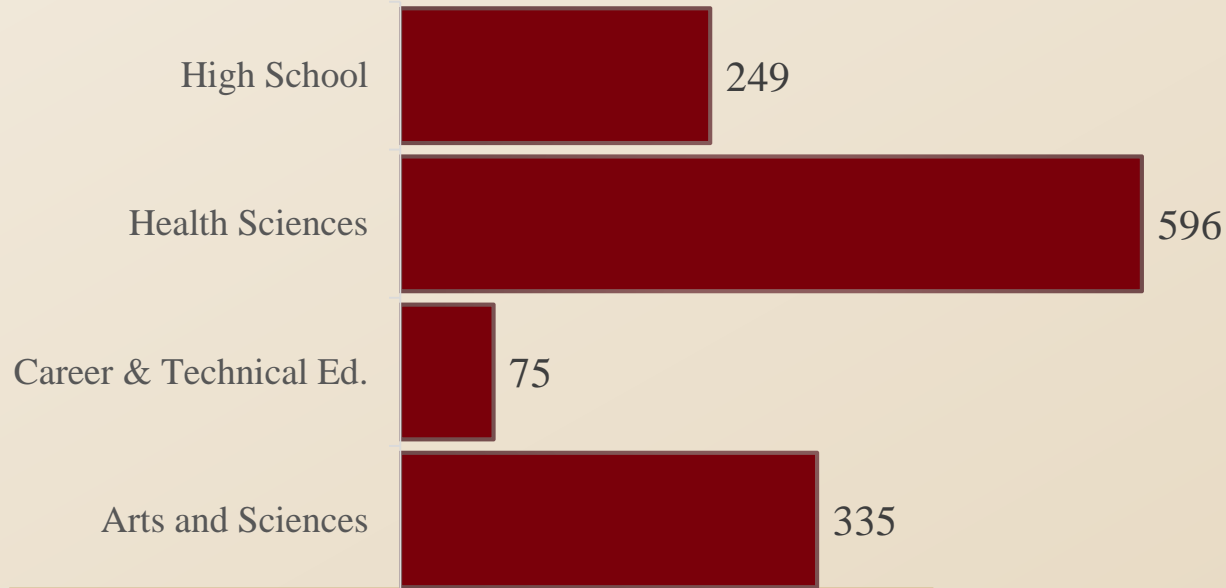

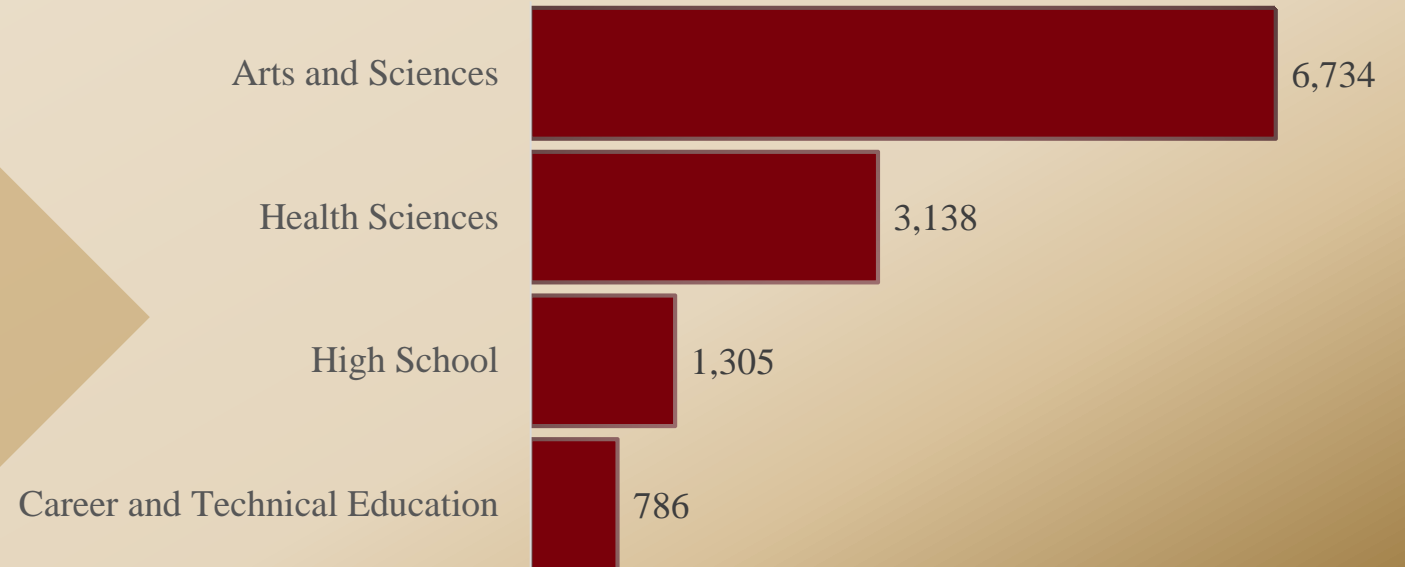
DECLARED DEGREES BY DIVISIONS FALL 2020

Graduation rates as reported are based on a cohort of first time at college/ full time students tracked through their academic career. Graduation rate is based on completion within 150% time to degree or certificate.

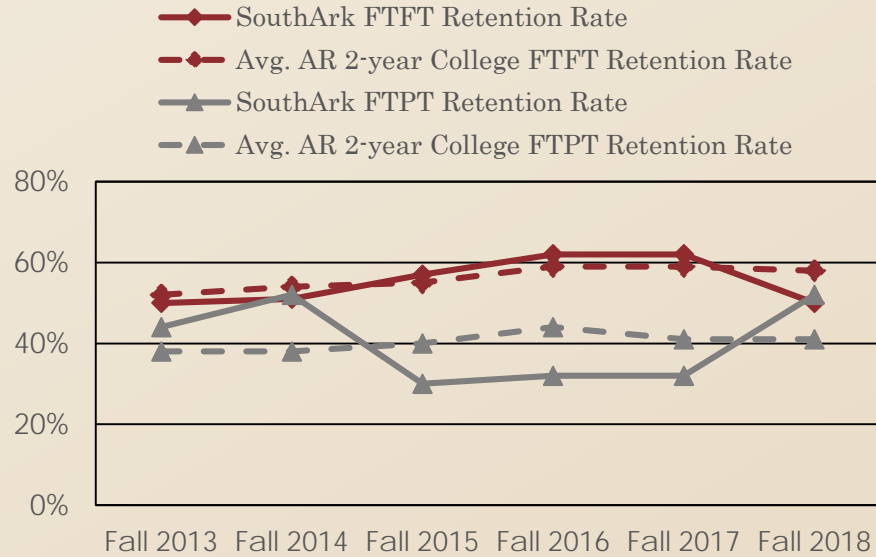


A technical certificate student is allowed 18 months to complete. An associate degree student is allowed three years to complete.

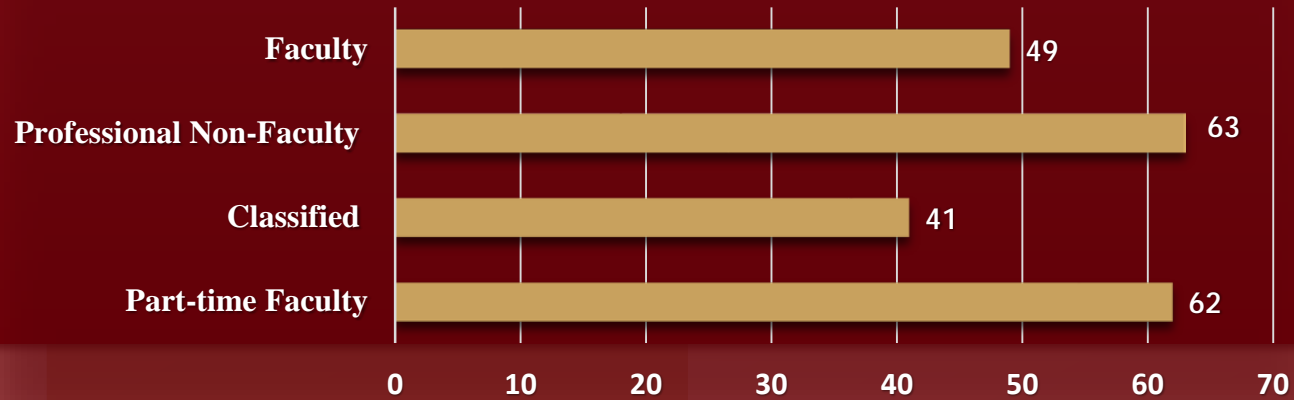

Despite the high percentage of part-time faculty, the majority of instruction at SouthArk is by full-time faculty.



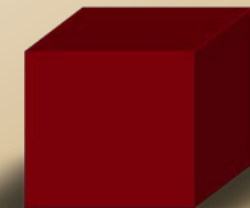
Student-to-faculty Ratio (2018)

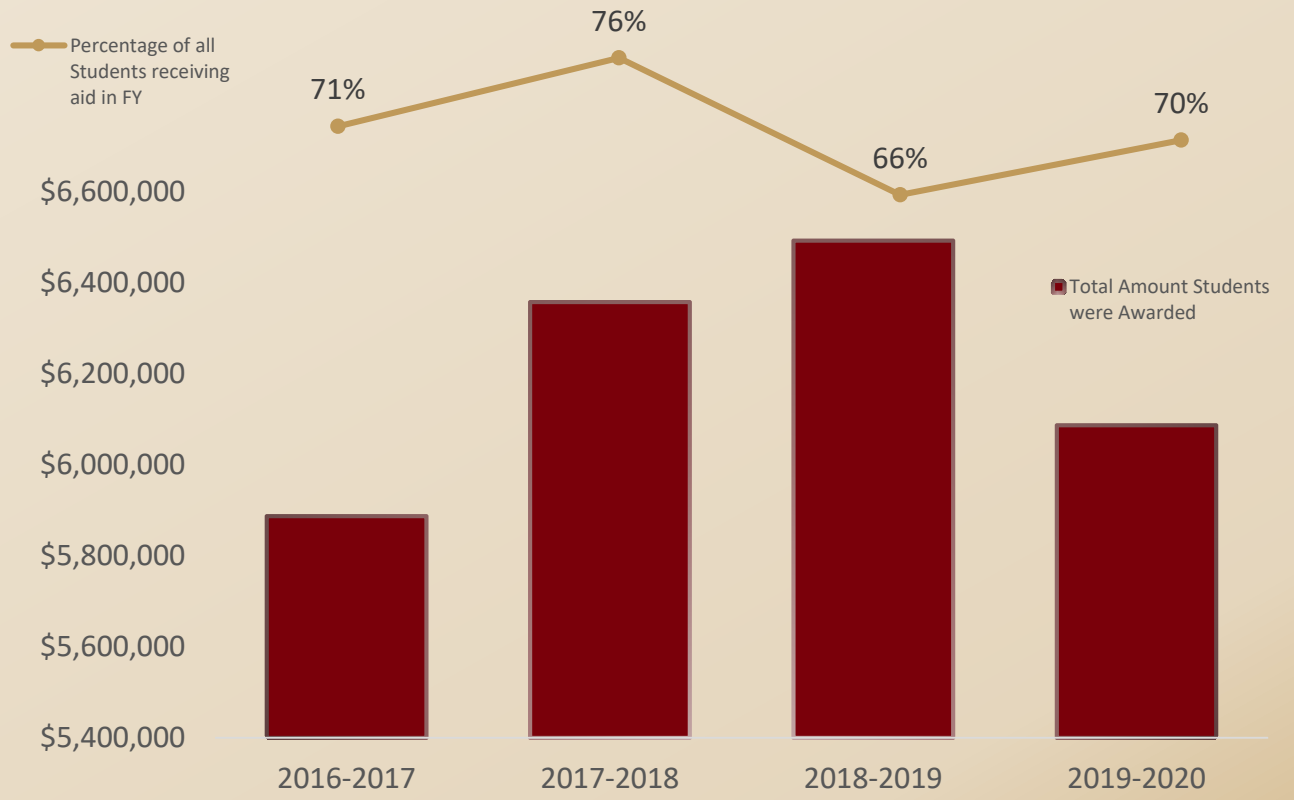
