

College Transition: To provide seamless transition...



Note: continue taking the ACT Senior year if desired score is not reached.

12th

Apply for Admissions, Scholarships, and Financial Aid. Know your deadlines. Challenge yourself!

11th

Attend local College Night. Narrow both college and major list to three. Tour top three schools.

Continue Concurrent classes. Look for leadership opportunities. Take ACT once in the Fall, twice in Spring, then in June.

10th

Create Interest Inventory. Narrow down school list to five.

Begin taking Concurrent Courses. Begin to request recommendation letters for college application/scholarships.

Look for ACT Prep classes & take the ACT the summer after sophomore year.

9th

Meet and know how to contact your Guidance Counselor.

List top 6 schools and top 4 desired majors. Research those schools/majors.

Join school- or community-based activities, clubs, and/or sports.

Learn about Concurrent Enrollment and consider participating.

At all Grade Levels:

- Focus on Academics (Grades)
- Draft and maintain a working resume/portfolio for awards, honors, certificates, and volunteer hours.
- Look for ways to save money for college. (save allowances, summer jobs, mowing lawns, etc.)
- Participate in Documented Community Service
