

Senior Spring Checklist

January

- Complete any unfinished college application materials.
- Turn in any college mid-year reports to the appropriate school officials.
- Order any required first semester transcripts.
- Review your seventh semester class rank.
- Assist parents, as needed, with completing your section of the FAFSA.
- Continue to work on scholarship applications.
- Find out the date for ordering graduation announcements, cap, and gown.

February

- Make sure that your FAFSA information is in the mail (or filed online) this month.
- Complete any unfinished college application materials.
- Continue to complete available scholarship applications.

March

- Watch the mail for your Student Aid Report (SAR) and review the information to see that it is all correct.
- Take a last minute college visit if needed.
- Write thank you notes to all individuals who wrote letters of recommendation on your behalf this year.
- Enjoy spring break!
- Continue to complete available scholarship applications.

April

- Review admissions letters received from colleges.
- Respond, in writing, by May 1 to all colleges with an accept or regret notification.
- Review financial aid award letters with your parents and respond accordingly.
- Return any requested housing or admission deposits.
- Sign up for your college summer orientation programs.

May

- Order final transcript for the college you plan to attend.
- If you have taken dual credit courses, make sure you have ordered a transcript from the college where you took the dual credit course and send the transcript to the college you will be attending in the fall.
- Study for final exams.
- Enjoy graduation activities.
- Get a summer job!
