Objectives of Partnership

1. To provide a seamless transition for student holding an Associate of Science in Education degree from South Arkansas Community College to University of Arkansas at Monticello.

Terms of Agreement

- 1. South Arkansas Community College will offer the courses listed on the "Associate of Science in Education" degree plan.
- 2. University of Arkansas at Monticello will accept the 68 credit hours completed, with grades of "C" or higher without prejudice.
- 3. University of Arkansas at Monticello will offer the remainder of courses for students to achieve the appropriate Bachelor's degree.
- 4. After completion of the BSES, students must complete an alternative route teaching program to receive a teaching license. University of Arkansas at Monticello's alternative teaching route is the Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT) program. The MAT program will allow Bachelor of Science in Educational Studies Non-Licensure degree students to seek licensure in K-6 Elementary Education, Middle Childhood grades 4-8, Secondary grades 7-12, Physical Education, Art, and Music K-12.

Recruitment Strategies

- 1. Faculty and staff of University of Arkansas at Monticello and South Arkansas Community College will continue to actively promote and recruit new cohorts.
- 2. Recruiting activities will include such events as informational seminars presented on the South Arkansas Community College campuses.

Admissions Requirements

- 1. Program admission requirements may differ from college and university admission requirements.
- 2. Admission to the university does not guarantee admission to a given program of study.

Number of Courses/Credit Hours: 52 credit hours, in addition to the Associate of Science in Education (ASE), are required for completion of the Bachelors of Science in Education Studies –Non-Licensure Degree.

Resources/Support Services Provided by Each Institution

- 1. University of Arkansas at Monticello faculty and staff will share expertise with South Arkansas Community College faculty and staff to maintain compatibility of its courses in the AS program.
- 2. South Arkansas Community College is responsible for the quality of courses taught by its faculty.
- 3. University of Arkansas at Monticello is responsible for the quality of courses taught by its faculty.

Memorandum of Understanding Renewal/Review: The Memorandum will be reviewed biennially.

Review Period: The first review period will be spring of 2022.

Modifications to Agreement/Notice Required: If the agreement requires modification, notice will be given by either party at least one semester in advance of proposed changes.

Review Committee and Approval: The School of Education for the University of Arkansas at Monticello and the Department of Education for South Arkansas Community College will partner in the review and renewal process as directed above.

Effective Date of Agreement: 1 July, 2020

Termination Date of Agreement:

- 1. Program will be subject to routine review.
- This agreement may be cancelled by either party with at least one academic year advance notification with clear plans to hold harmless (i.e. satisfy course offering expectations) any students, who are currently enrolled in the program and remain full-time in the program of study.
