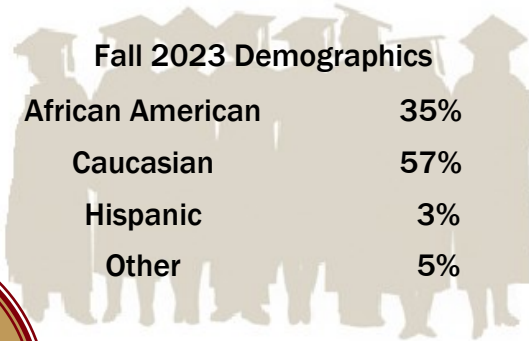
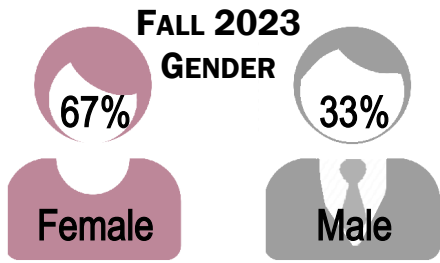

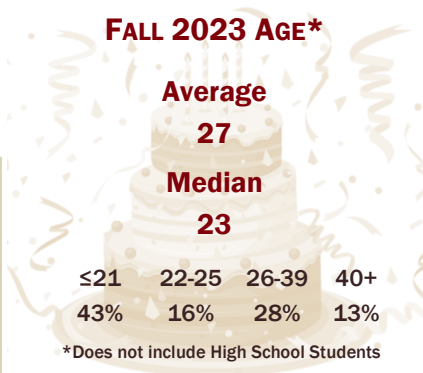

SouthArk's Average Student to Faculty Ratio is 13:1

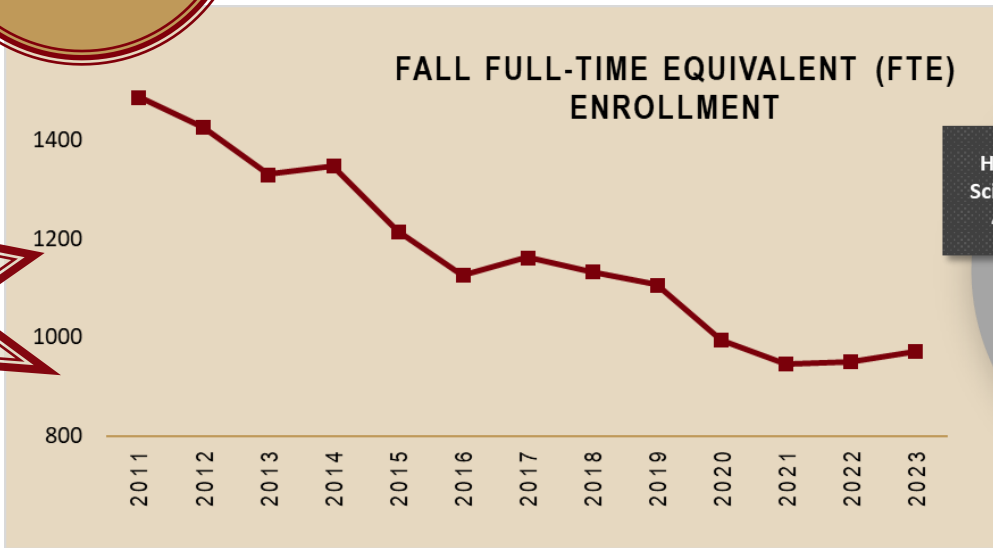

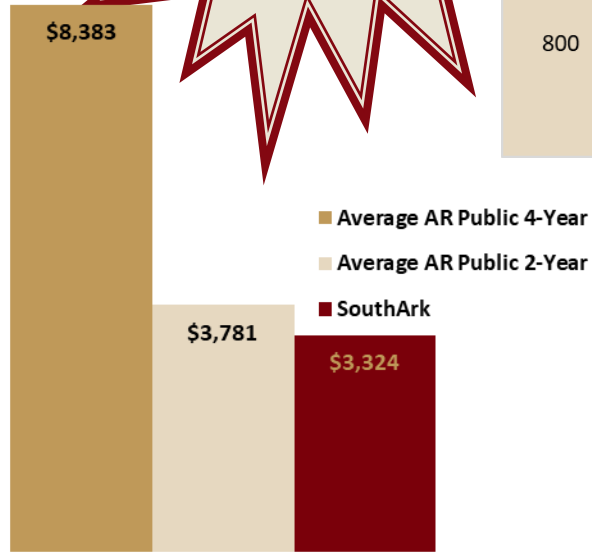
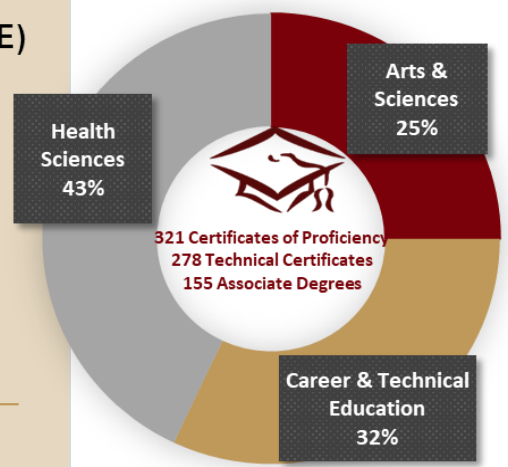
