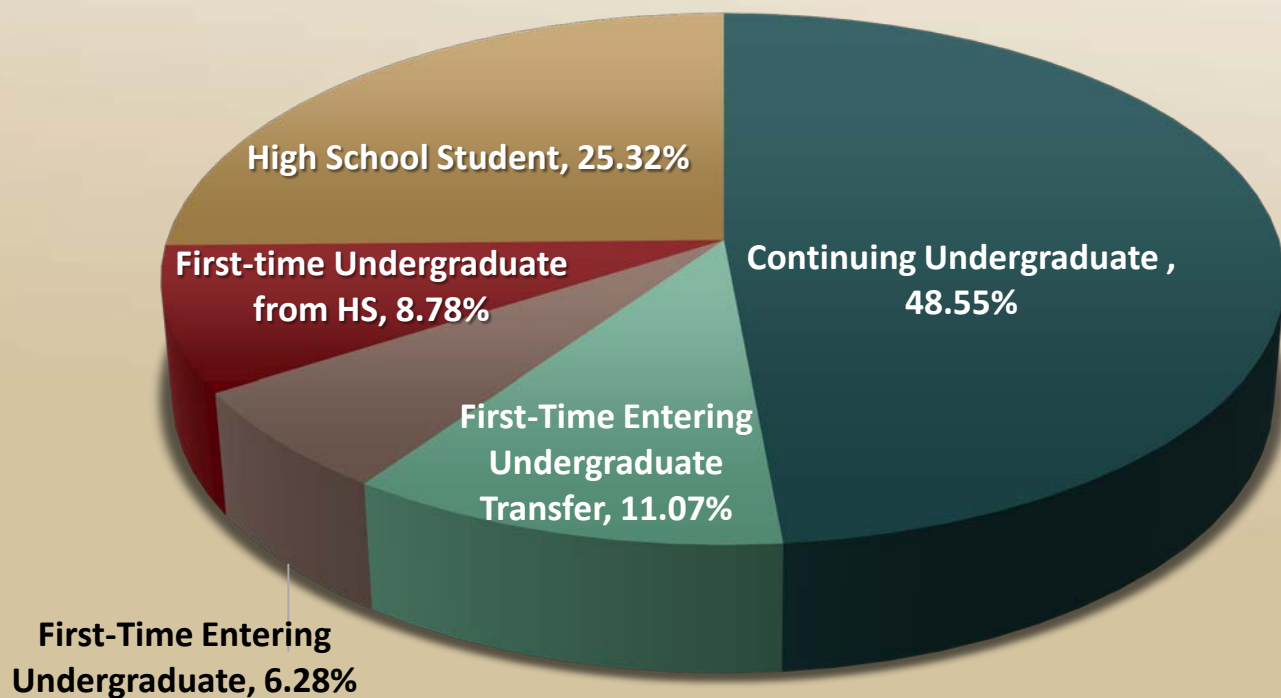




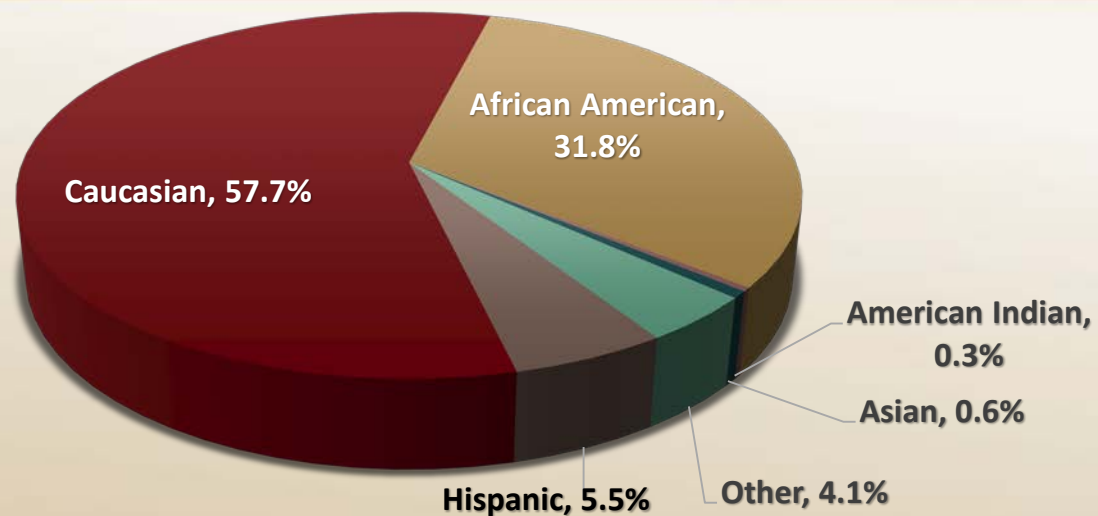
Classification of Enrollments Fall 2017

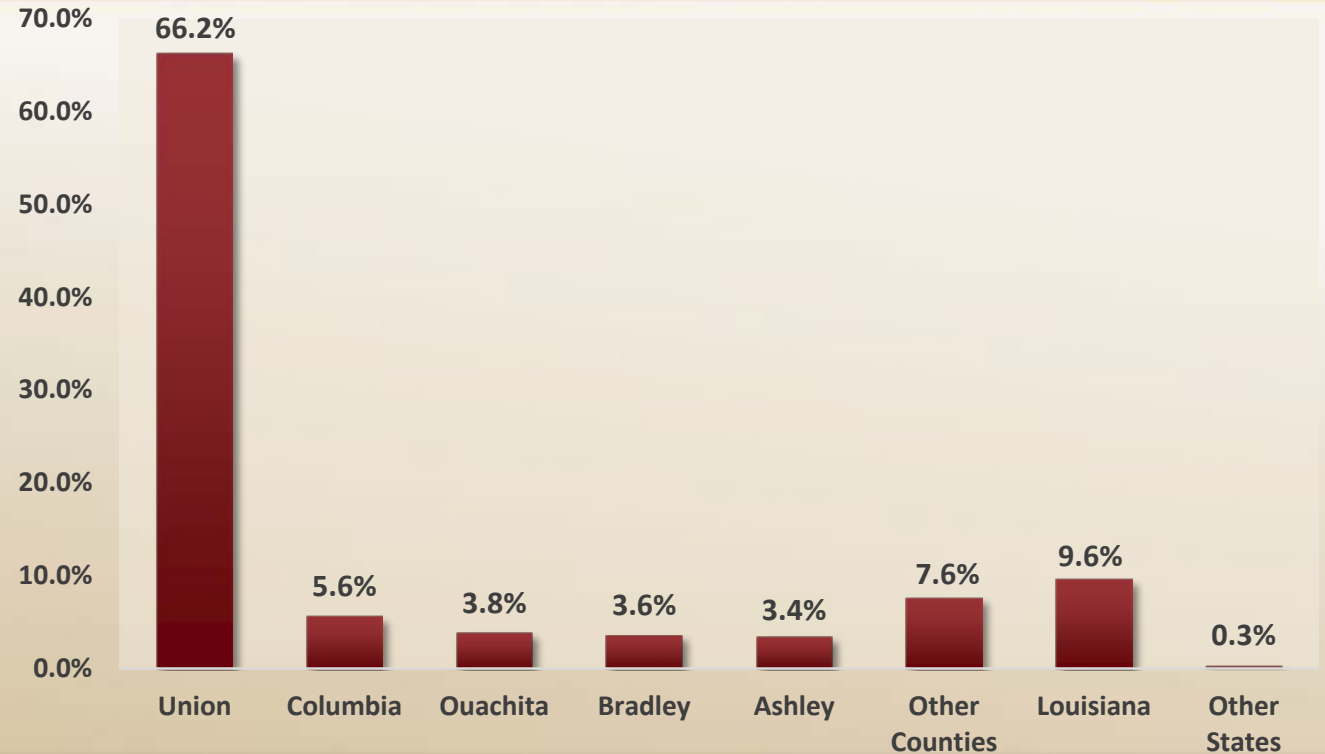

Fall Enrollment 2012 - 2017

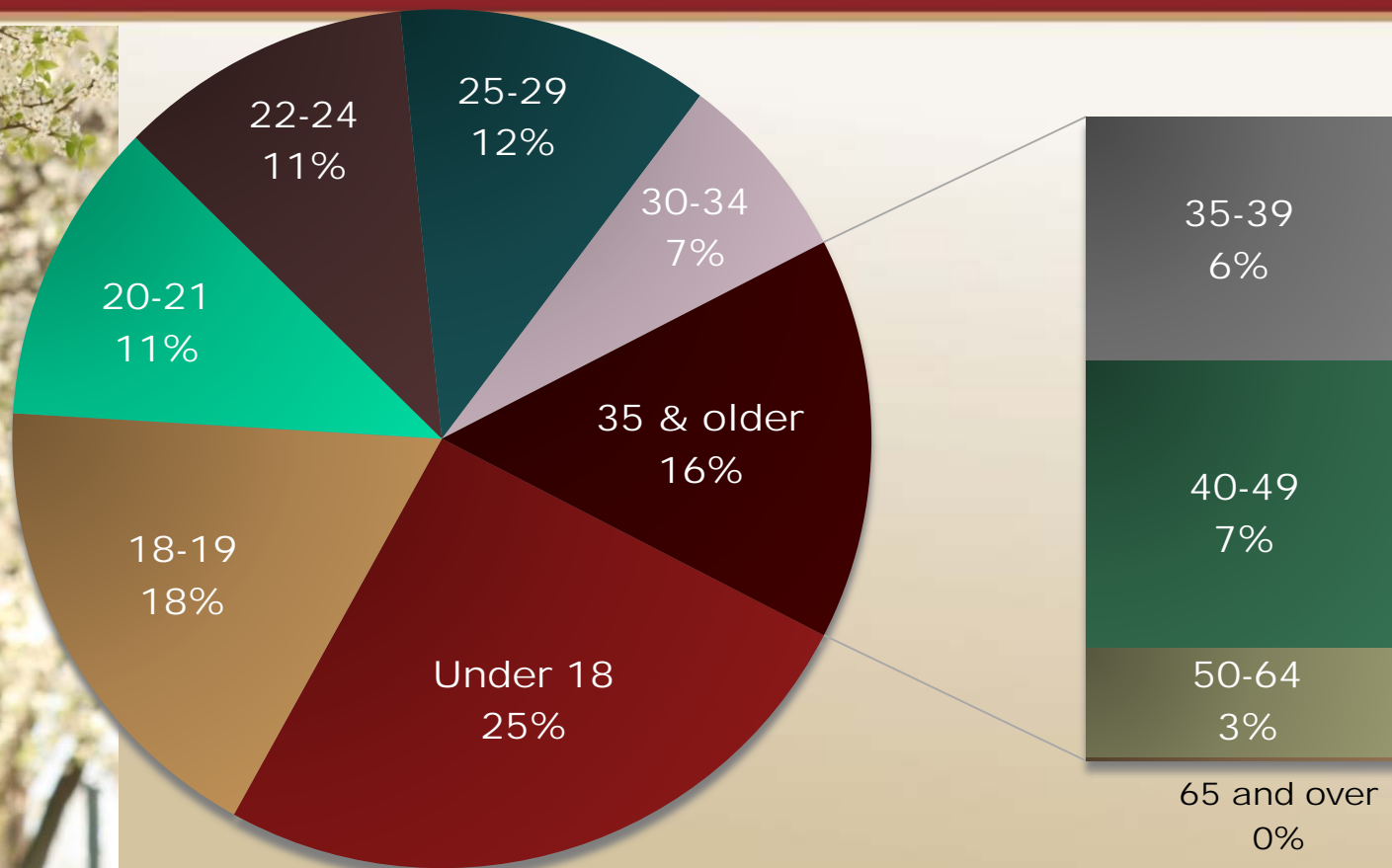
