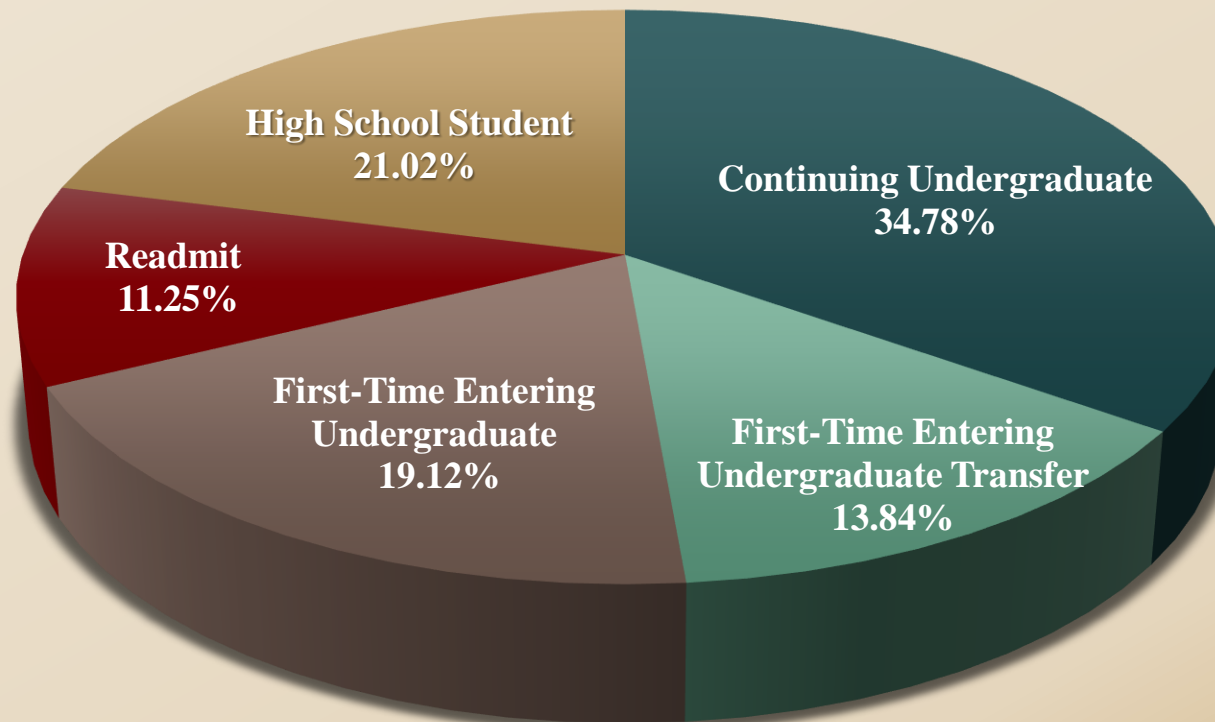
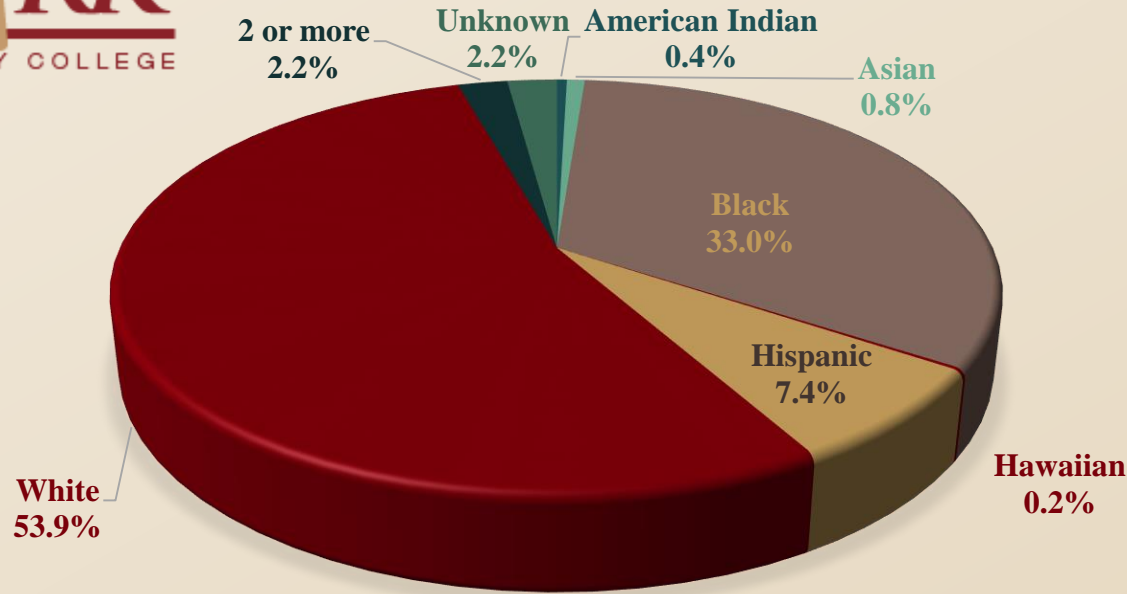


CLASSIFICATION OF ENROLLMENTS FALL 2021

ENROLLMENT BY ETHNICITY FALL 2021



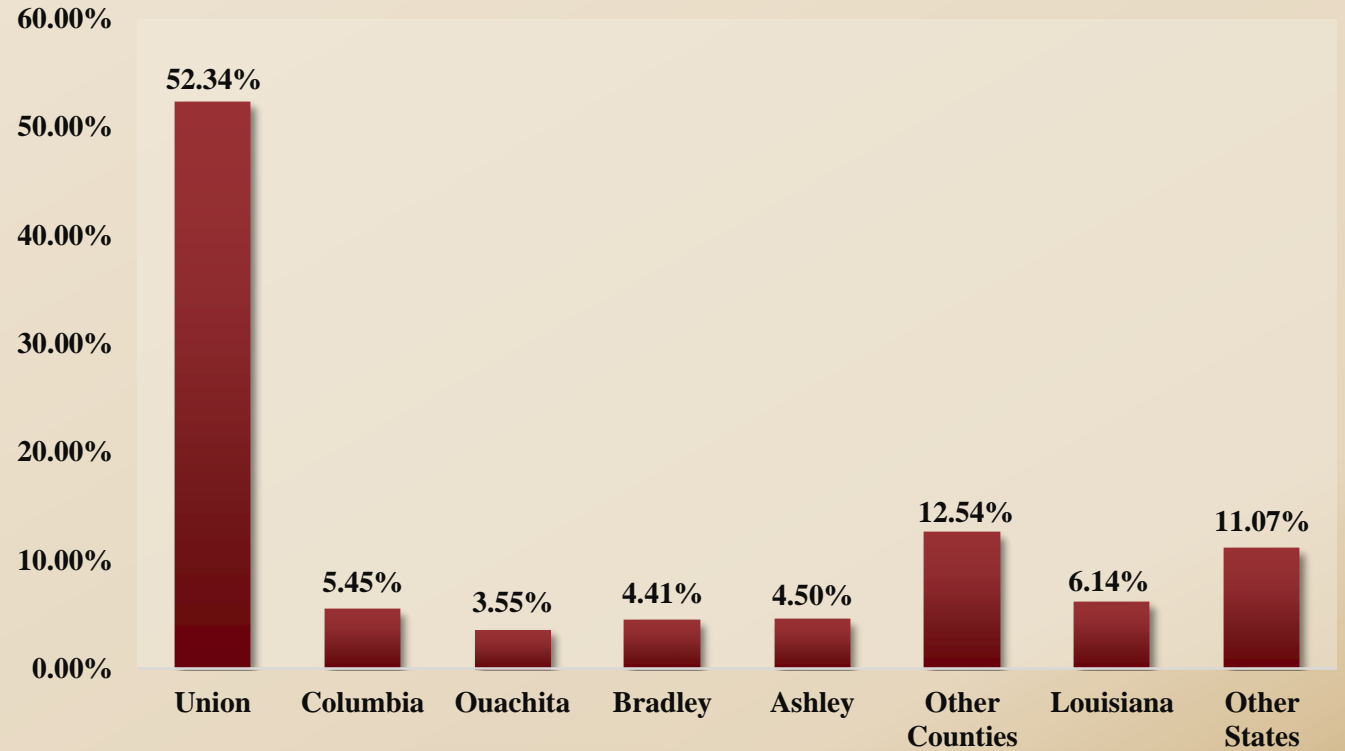

While SouthArk's service area is defined as Ashley, Bradley, Chicot, and Union counties, our students come from all over the region.

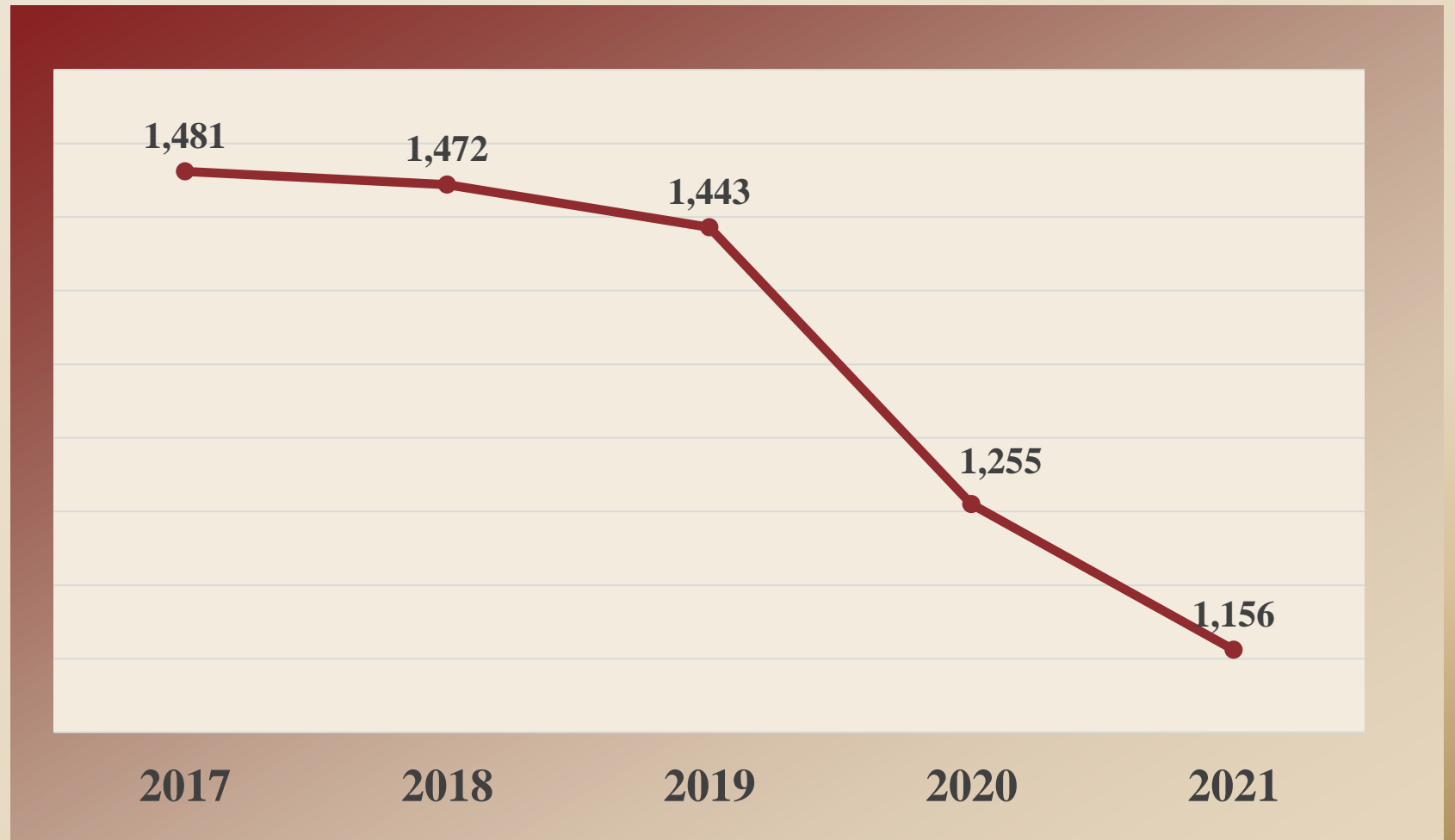

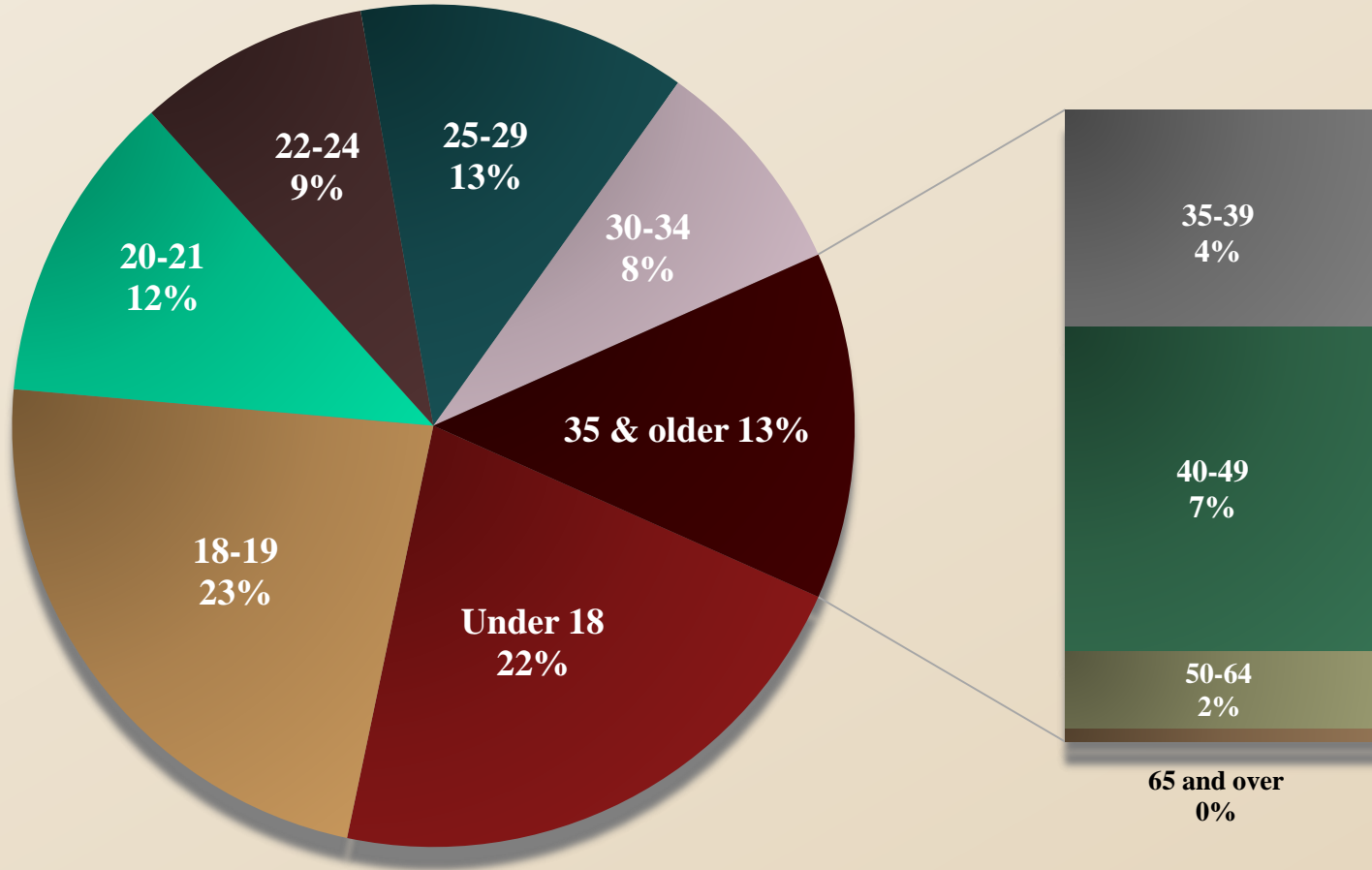

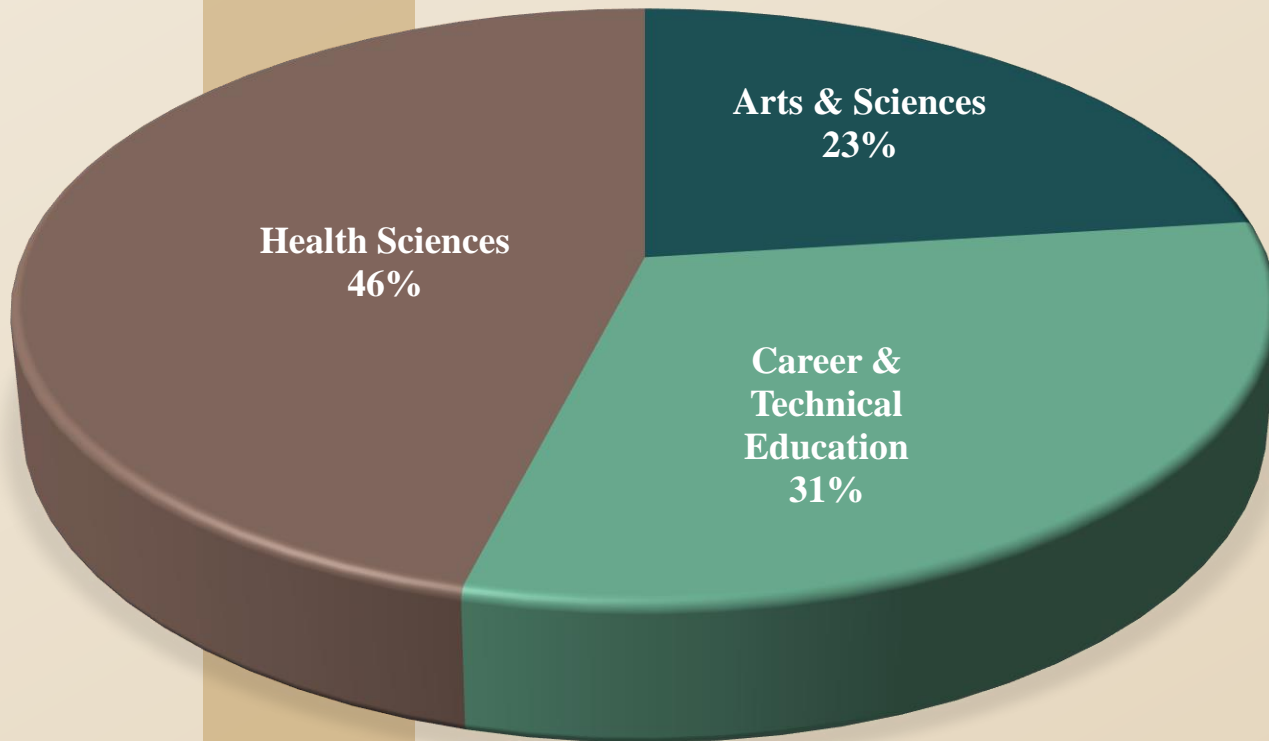
AGE OF ENROLLMENTS FALL 2021

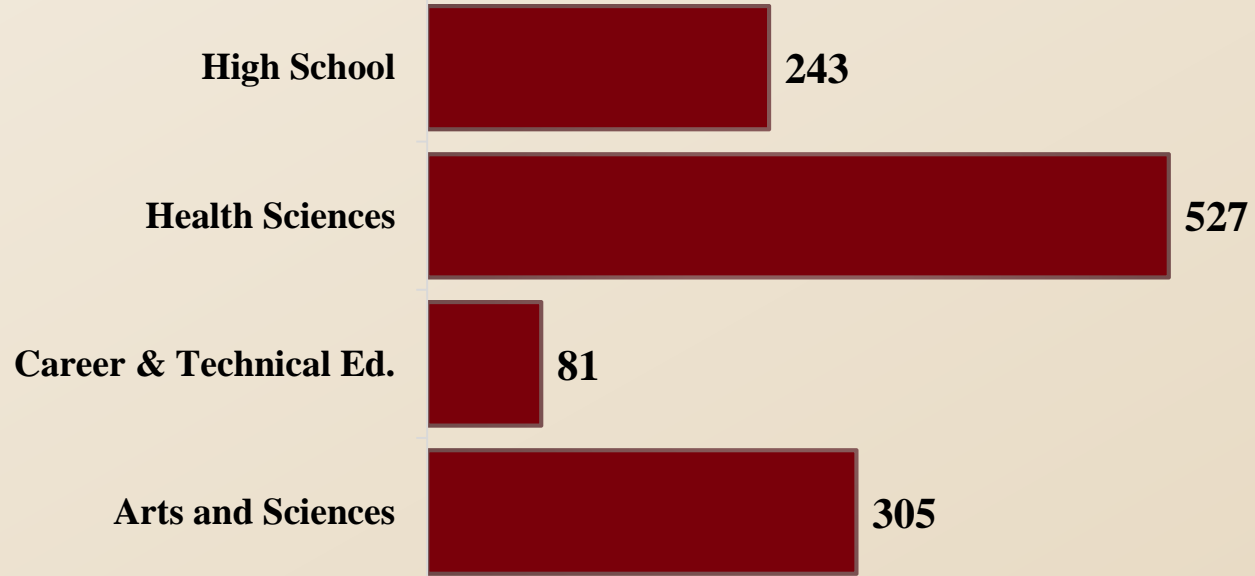

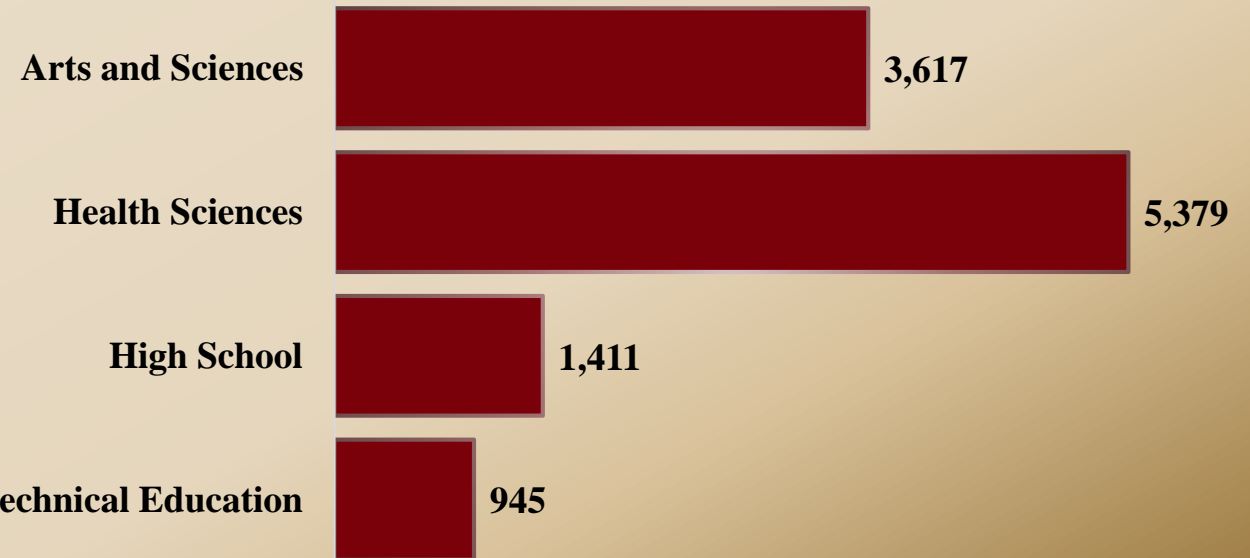

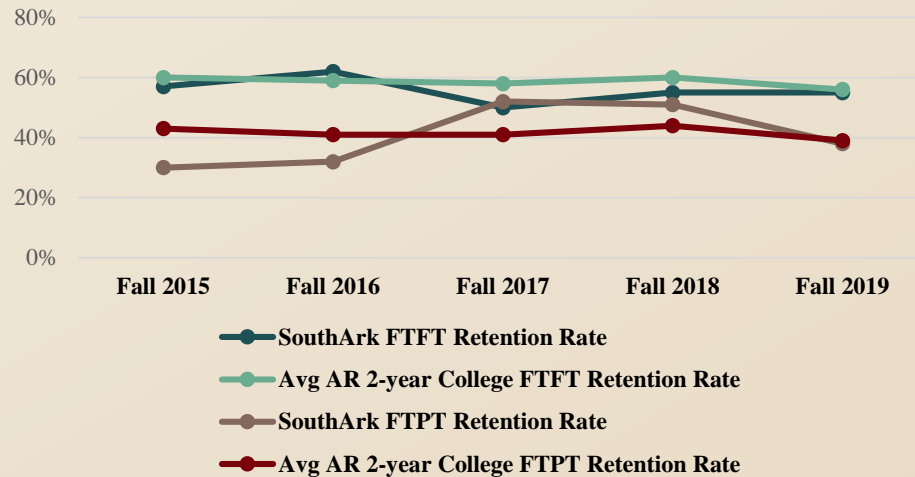

Fall to Fall Retention



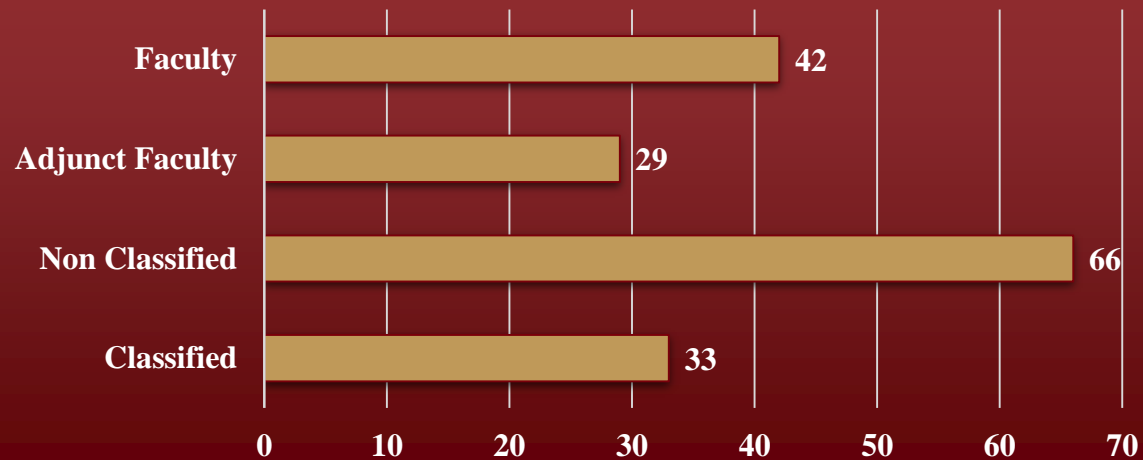

Despite the high percentage of part-time faculty, full-time faculty contribute to the majority of instruction at SouthArk.

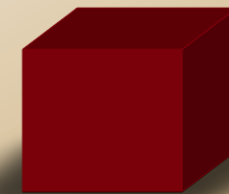
Student-to-faculty Ratio (2020)

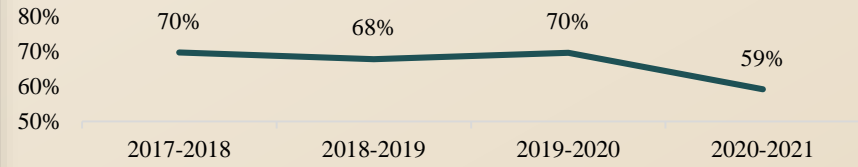

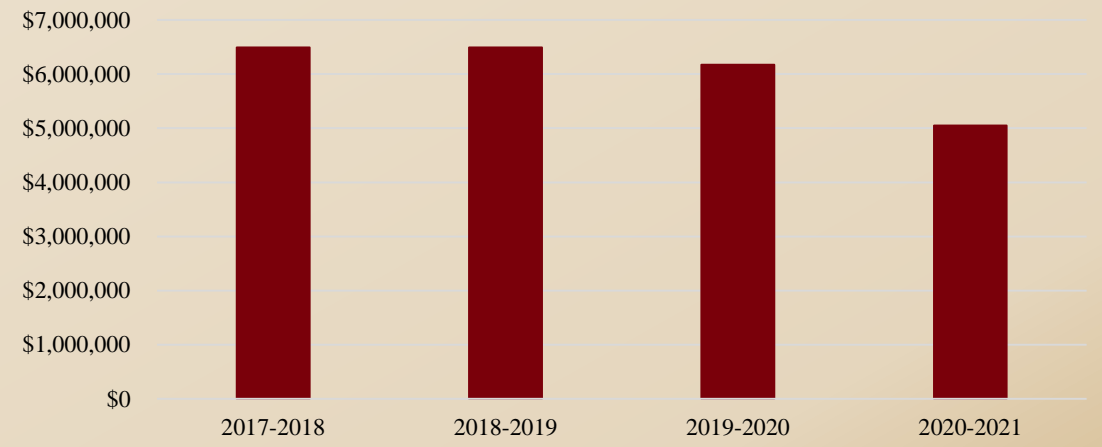


Percentage of all students receiving aid
