COMMENTS AND NOTES:

Program Description	This is an LPN/LVN-to-RN transition program as part of ARNEC (Arkansas Rural Nursing Education Consortium). Graduates receive an Associate of Applied Science (AAS) in Registered Nursing. The program consists of theory classes, laboratory experiences, and clinical within various health care facilities in the region. Travel to some facilities is required. Student must provide own transportation.
Program Requirements	66 TOTAL Program Credit Hours. Minimum GPA of 2.5 cumulative for 10 prerequisite courses and completion of 'NACE I' pre-entrance exam; Selective admission and application; Must hold an active, valid, unencumbered LPN license for admission; Demonstration of PN skills competency will be required upon admission. Applicants may lack ONLY ONE of the required general education courses by the application deadline of August 31, which may not be a course that was attempted previously and earned a D or F. That course must be successfully completed in the fall semester preceding the Jan. program start date. All remaining courses must be successfully completed/passed prior to the program entry spring semester. Students must earn a grade of 'C' or better in all prerequisite and program courses to progress in program and to successfully complete and graduate from the program. No additional courses may be taken concurrently with the nursing courses during the program. After successful completion of all program courses, graduates will be eligible to apply to take the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX). Graduation from the LPN-to-RN program does not automatically ensure that the graduate will be allowed to take the NCLEX-RN, nor does it ensure that the graduate will pass the licensure exam. Eligibility to take the NCLEX-RN is dependent on meeting standards in the Arkansas State Board Nurse Practice Act and rules (or the applicable state's Nursing Board that the graduate is applying for licensure). Upon successful completion of the NCLEX-RN, graduate will be a licensed registered nurse (RN).
