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COMMENTS AND NOTES:

Program Description	The Practical Nursing (PN) Program at South Arkansas Community College is designed to prepare the graduate for an entry level nursing career in a variety of health care environments. Successful graduates will earn a Technical Certificate (TC) in Practical Nursing from the college and will be eligible to apply to take the National Council Licensure Examination for Practical Nurses (NCLEX-PN) and apply for licensure through the Arkansas State Board of Nursing, which allows the individual to practice as a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN). The HS program begins in the fall semester and concludes the next August (3 semesters: fall, spring and summer).
Program Requirements	49 TOTAL Program credit hours. Completion of all remediation requirements; Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00; All prerequisite courses must be completed with grade of 'C' or better prior to program entry (GPA in prerequisite courses = min. of 2.00). Application required; Selective admission; Applicants will be selected based on a point system derived from a combination of cumulative GPA, prerequisite GPA, and TEAS scores. TEAS requirements: See https://www.southark.edu/academics/health-science/teas-exam ; TEAS results must be delivered by student to nursing dept. on day of testing; Selected students must pass a criminal background check and drug screen and are required to have all immunizations, vaccinations, testings, & screenings required by clinical facilities. After successful completion of all program courses (grade of 'C' or higher in all program courses), graduates will be eligible to register for the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX). Graduation from the practical nursing program does not automatically enable the graduate to sit for the NCLEX-PN. Eligibility to take the NCLEX-PN is dependent on meeting standards in the Arkansas State Board Nurse Practice Act and rules (or the standards of the Nursing Board in the state for which the graduate intends to apply for licensure). Graduation from the program does not ensure that the graduate will pass the NCLEX-PN licensure exam or be granted a license by the Arkansas State Board of Nursing
