- The computer-based, or electronic panic button: offers users another option in which Alertus Desktop Notification provides panic button features at any computer through the use of hotkeys and system tray emergency buttons.
- The Alertus Activation App: allows authorized dispatchers to send preset alerts as well as view or cancel active alerts.
- The Alertus App: notifies targeted students, faculty, and personnel when an emergency alert has been activated.
