Do you have reliable access to a computer and the internet?

To be a successful student in online courses you'll need to have regular unlimited access to a computer and the internet. You cannot complete all requirements on a phone or tablet.

Do you frequently use e-mail and browse the web?

Online coursework can include completing assignments, participating in discussions, reading daily announcements, participating in online course activities, responding to emails, etc. If you are not accustomed to routinely accessing the internet, you may find online coursework to be difficult.

Can You Attend ALL Classes and Meet ALL Due Dates?

To ensure they don't miss important course materials and due dates, successful students log into their online courses and interact several times a week. Classes may have synchronous meetings you have to attend in "real-time."

Online Learner Characteristics

- Independently keep up with a daily calendar of material to review and items that are due.
- Be comfortable asking the instructor and Academic Support for help
- Attention to a variety of details in a virtual space
- Internally motivated to stay on track with course learning, assignments, and testing.
