data to grow the current volunteer program. They will develop volunteer job descriptions, identify recruitment and retention best practices, train staff on how to effectively work with and train volunteers, and evaluate the effectiveness of the program. The VISTA will also become familiar with AHRQ and other resources that relate to Health Literacy and adapt resources in the Toolkit to create Standard Operating Procedures for the Clinic on Health Literacy. The candidate will survey patients to identify barriers related to spoken, written, self-care management, and support systems, and provider training to staff to implement Health Literacy workflows. The candidate will partner with SHARE Foundation's Resource Development Director to identify funding opportunities for these projects.
