| Licensure | In order to become licensed and work as a physical therapist assistant, a PTA graduate must pass a national board test, and fulfill licensure requirements within the state they will work in. |
| Career Opportunities | PTA graduates find employment in a variety of healthcare facilities and departments, including, but not limited to, acute care, rehab, out-patient, school system, home health, nursing homes, and pediatric settings. Average entry-level annual salary \$50,000 |
| Transfer Paths and Requirements | A Doctorate of Physical Therapy, DPT, is the terminal degree to become a physical therapist. It requires a bachelor's degree followed by the completion of a CAPTE accredited PT graduate school. There are multiple PT schools within Arkansas. There are only two colleges in the USA that offer a bridge PTA-to-PT degree program, neither of these are within Arkansas. |
