

BASIC STUDIES REQUIREMENTS:

Reading: ACT 19 or above (or) ASSET 43 or above (or) COMPASS 83 or above (or) Accuplacer Classic 78/ Next Generation 253 or above (or) complete BSTD 0613 English II.

Writing: ACT 19 or above (or) ASSET 45 or above (or) COMPASS 80 or above (or) Accuplacer Classic 83/ Next Generation 253 or above (or) complete BSTD 0613 English II.

Math: ACT 19 or above (or) ASSET Intermediate Algebra 39 or above (or) COMPASS Algebra 41 or above (or) Accuplacer Classic 78/ Next Generation 256 or above (or) complete BSTD 0513 Intermediate Algebra

I understand that when seeking a credential, I may be required to enroll in basic studies (BSTD) courses as a result of my test scores in compliance with Arkansas Law, Act 1052, which may take additional semesters for successful completion.

COMMENTS AND NOTES:

After successful completion of all program courses, graduates will be eligible to register for the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX). Graduation from the practical nursing program does not automatically enable the graduate to sit for the NCLEX-PN. Eligibility to take the NCLEX-PN is dependent on meeting standards in the Arkansas State Board Nurse Practice Act and rules (or Nursing Board graduate is applying for licensure to). Graduation from the program does not ensure that the graduate will pass the NCLEX-PN licensure exam. Upon successful completion of the NCLEX-PN, graduate will be a licensed practical nurse.

Program Description	The PN program is designed to prepare the successful graduates who pass the NCLEX-PN licensure exam to provide diverse types of nursing care in a variety of health care environments for patients across the lifespan. The day program begins in the long summer semester and concludes the next May (3 semesters).
Program Requirements	Program = 51 credit hours total. Completion of all BSTD requirements; Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.00; All prerequisite courses must be completed with grade of 'C' or better prior to program entry (GPA in prerequisite courses = min. of 2.00); May be enrolled in <u>only two</u> of the three prerequisite courses in the semester that immediately precedes program entry; Students admitted to the program are not allowed to take any non-program courses concurrently while in the program. Application required; Selective admission; Applicants will be selected based on a point system derived from a combination of cumulative GPA, prerequisite GPA, and TEAS scores. TEAS must be within one year of application deadline & results must be delivered by student to nursing dept. on day of testing; Minimum TEAS scores: Reading 45, Math 30, Science 30, English 35, and Composite 40; Selected students must pass a criminal background check and drug screen.
