


CLASSIFICATION OF ENROLLMENTS FALL 2018


SouthArk's student body is made up of students at all points in their College education from High School students earning dual credits to students returning to finish a degree.



While SouthArk's service area is defined as Ashley, Bradley, Chicot, and Union counties, our students come from all over the region.





ENROLLMENT BY FALL 2008-2018







AGE OF ENROLLMENTS FALL 2018





150% time to degree or certificate. A technical certificate student is allowed 18 months to complete. An associate degree student is allowed three years to complete.






FALL TO FALL RETENTION 2011-2016


