MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ARKANSAS TECH UNIVERSITY

AND

SOUTH ARKANSAS COLLEGE

Effective January 01, 2019

Article I

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), once accepted and signed by the Presidents of both institutions, supersedes and replaces any existing MOU agreements that may exist between Arkansas Tech University (ATU) and South Arkansas Community College (SouthArk). This MOU may be modified without approval to comply with the requirements of the Arkansas General Assembly, the Arkansas Department of Higher Education, the Higher Learning Commission, or other applicable accrediting agencies.

ATU and SouthArk agree that a student transferring to ATU from SouthArk who has completed the courses identified in the major guaranteed transfer list identified in Appendix C, who has successfully completed all the required transfer procedures, and has been accepted for admission at ATU, and had transferred credit awarded for previously earned hours in the applicable major for the degree being pursued, will be awarded transfer credit by ATU for those courses in the applicable major for the degree.

Appendix A outlines the agreement for students who are transferring from SouthArk to ATU and establishing residency.

Appendix B outlines the operational procedures for all programs covered by this MOU, whether delivered online or on Arkansas Tech University campus.

Appendix C outlines degrees and courses covered by this MOU

Article II

Agreement of Principles

Degree and program requirements for the awarding of an ATU degree to students who transfer from SouthArk to ATU under this agreement will be determined by the date of the transferring student's initial enrollment at SouthArk College. ATU publishes catalog and curriculum requirements on the website by March of each year for the subsequent year. Students may graduate under the ATU catalog in force at the time of the transferring student's enrollment at SouthArk or any subsequent ATU catalog. ATU reserves the right to make any change, effective immediately, in graduation requirements for students whose programs have revised accreditation requirements.

It is agreed that both institutions will work together to ensure initial and continuing accreditation of the programs under this agreement by the Higher Learning Commission and by the corresponding accrediting association for specific programs.

As more fully set forth in Appendix A, a SouthArk student who has successfully completed 51% or more of the required coursework for his or her major field of study with the requisite GPA and who has transferred to an ATU program identified in this Memorandum, whether online or ATU (Russellville) campus, may be eligible to be awarded an Associate's Degree from SouthArk. Awarding this degree will require the student to have successfully completed the requirements for the Associates Degree with the required GPA and will also require SouthArk to have formally requested the student's transcript from ATU. The policy, procedure, and activation of such action for making this request will be the responsibility of SouthArk and is subject to any Arkansas Department of Higher Education (ADHE) requirements or regulations.

It is agreed that, subject to the terms of this Agreement, and as more fully set forth in Appendix A, SouthArk students who have satisfactorily completed with the required GPA all required junior and senior level course work at ATU, either online or on the Russellville campus, or who have been awarded credit for transfer work from another university counting towards degree requirements, and who meet all program requirements, will earn a baccalaureate degree from ATU. Upper level transfer credit must be requested by the student and awarded in accordance with current ATU policy at the time of the student's transfer.

SouthArk students transferring to ATU under this Agreement will be eligible for admission at ATU and will transfer into their selected program without loss of credit, providing they meet the requirements of the terms set forth in this Agreement, including the attached curricula, as well as ATU admissions criteria. Students at SouthArk who wish to transfer to ATU must complete an ATU application for admission and meet degree requirements listed in the appropriate ATU catalog subject to the exception as follows:

Transfer students from SouthArk College to ATU will be required to meet general education and major-specific requirements, as well as complete 40 junior/senior level hours at Arkansas Tech University or other accredited four-year institution of higher education. A minimum of thirty credit hours must be Arkansas Tech University hours.

Representatives from both institutions will have input into all decisions that directly impact the transfer program that is the subject of this Agreement. Prospective SouthArk degree-seeking students will be provided complete information concerning the academic preparation required for enrollment in the ATU courses and programs offered.

Both institutions agree that new programs may be added to this MOU upon approval by the Arkansas Department of Higher Education, the President of SouthArk, and the President of ATU.

Both institutions agree that either the President of SouthArk or the President of ATU with one-year written notice may remove an academic program from this MOU upon request. The parties further agree that any students currently enrolled in a course of study that is removed from this MOU will be permitted to complete the course of study they are enrolled in under the terms of this Agreement.

Any curricular and/or program changes impacting a program under this agreement by SouthArk must be communicated to ATU in a timely manner, allowing at least one full academic semester of review and approval by ATU. Changes in ATU curriculum or programs under this agreement must be communicated to SouthArk in a consistent timely manner allowing for any necessary adjustments.

Presidential approvals will be demonstrated by both Presidents signing and dating a new MOU signature page each time this MOU is modified.

The initial term of this Agreement shall begin on January 1, 2019, and shall expire on June 30, 2020. The agreement shall be reviewed at this time, and annually thereafter, by both parties for continuance. Either party may cancel this agreement without cause upon one years' written notice to the other party. Both parties agree that, in the event of termination of the Agreement, any student currently enrolled under or participating in the programs offered under this Agreement shall be permitted to complete this course of study under the terms of this Agreement.

Article A-l Agreements of Program

This Memorandum of Agreement (hereinafter "Agreement") is made between and entered into by South Arkansas Community College (SouthArk) and Arkansas Tech University (ATU), which have agreed to cooperate for the purpose of assisting SouthArk graduates to complete at ATU a Bachelor of Science, Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Applied Science, Bachelor in Professional Studies, or in programs where curriculum paths have been identified and accepted by both institutions. It is the purpose of the Agreement to offer SouthArk students a seamless transfer option for the completion of a Bachelor Degree at ATU. Through collaborative efforts, the partners desire to increase graduation rates, facilitate the transfer process, and maintain a high quality working relationship between the two institutions.

This MOU addresses the educational degree opportunities available to SouthArk students who have completed or are satisfactorily progressing towards an accepted SouthArk Associates degree in an academic discipline that has been identified and accepted under this agreement.

If a degree is not completed at the time of the transfer from SouthArk, those courses taken in pursuit of an identified degree and completed with a grade of "C" or above will be accepted by ATU. Any unfulfilled lower-level degree coursework that is taken and passed with a minimum grade of "C" or above at ATU that would equal an associate's degree requirement will be reverse-transferred back to SouthArk.

ATU operates under a selective admissions policy. Transferring students from SouthArk are subject to all criteria and procedures relative to this admissions policy. These admission criteria and procedures are available on the ATU Admission website.

Students must earn a grade of "C" or higher in courses taken at SouthArk in order for the credits to transfer to ATU for articulation into a Bachelor Degree program.

The ATU/SouthArk Representative will make every effort to inform students of the transferability of the SouthArk degrees and courses to ATU. Statements about the partnership agreement on identified and accepted programs will also appear in/on both the ATU and SouthArk catalogs, websites, and any other mutually agreed upon recruiting, advertising, or promotional initiatives.

Catalogs/curricular requirements are available on the ATU webpage (http://www.atu.edu). These updates are available by March 1 of each year.

Information regarding transfer scholarships will be made available to students while attending SouthArk.

APPENDIX B

OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES
ARKANSAS TECH UNIVERSITY/SOUTH ARKANSAS COMMUNITY COLLEGE PARTNERSHIP
January 1, 2019

PRE-ADMISSION CONSULTATION:

The ATU/ SouthArk representative at SouthArk, who is appointed by SouthArk administration and who is a member of the SouthArk faculty or staff, will provide the student with information about the ATU transfer degree programs offered for SouthArk Students.

The ATU/ SouthArk Representative at SouthArk will provide the student with information about ATU criteria and procedures for admission, registration, financial aid, tuition and fees, etc.

STUDENT ADMISSION:

The student will complete the ATU online application for admission at http://www.atu.edu/admissions.

The student will provide official transcript(s) from all universities or colleges attended and proof of immunization to ATU along with any other required documentation to satisfy the enrollment criteria and procedures.

After evaluation of application and transcript(s) and any other requirements, the ATU Admissions Office will mail successful applicants an acceptance letter.

If the student will only be transferring SouthArk course work covered by this MOU, no Request for Substitution of Transfer Course form will need to be completed by the student.

If the student will be transferring course work from institutions other than SouthArk, the Department Head of the department owning the destination degree at Arkansas Tech University will review the work and complete a Request for Substitution of Transfer Course form for each college the student has attended. If SouthArk College has previously granted credit for a transfer course(s), ATU will accept this substitution for the SouthArk College class it was substituted for so long as it meets ATU standards for substitution. In situations where a course was transferred and accepted but not assigned to a specific course in the SouthArk College curriculum, the above process will be observed.

The Request for Substitution of Transfer Courses form(s) will be forwarded to the appropriate ATU department head, dean, and Registrar for consideration and review.

If approved, the ATU Registrar's Office will return the approved Request for Substitution of Transfer Courses form(s) to the requesting Department Head for future advising.

REGISTRATION

For students transferring to ATU, the ATU Transfer Recruiter or their Representatives will assist the student with registration on the ATU Online Registration System and will provide instruction on how to obtain an online schedule in OneTech.

TUITION AND FEE PAYMENT:

Payment of ATU tuition and all other fees and charges, including room and board charges for students in residence halls, are due and payable prior to the beginning of each term. Financial settlement may be made by personal payment or AUTHORIZED financial aid (loans, scholarships, grants, third parties, etc.).

- Credit card and eCheck payments are only accepted through OneTech under "Payment Options".
- Cash and check payments may be made at the Student Accounts cashier window in RCB Room
- E-cashier- Payment Plan Option (available on student's OneTech account)

Students enrolling in ATU classes will pay the standard published ATU charges for tuition and fees according to the following schedule:

Students enrolling in ATU classes and have no financial aid

The student will be responsible for payment of 100% of tuition and fees. Pre-registered students will receive a statement with the payment due date. This date will always be prior to the beginning of the semester. Students registering late must make payment of 100% of tuition and fees on the day they register.

Students classified as non-degree seeking at ATU and have financial aid

The student will pay 100% of tuition and fees due to ATU. Pre-registered students will receive a statement with the due date. This date will always be prior to the beginning of the semester. Students registering late must make payment of 100% of tuition and fees on the day they register or make arrangements for payment plans in accordance with existing ATU criteria and procedures.

Students classified as degree seeking at ATU and have financial aid

The student account will be paid by financial aid and any excess financial aid will be disbursed to the student by ATU via a mailed check, in accordance with the ATU calendar. Any remaining account balance after financial aid has applied will be due immediately to ATU.

Graduation Honors

The bachelor's degree with honors will be conferred upon candidates who at graduation have earned a minimum grade point average on all ATU courses: Summa Cum Laude-3.900 - 4.000, Magna Cum Laude-3.700 - 3.899, Cum Laude-3.500 - 3.699. Graduation honors will be determined by work from ATU courses only.

Commencement Participation

Students must complete all degree requirements prior to participating in the December, May, or August commencement ceremonies. Students completing all degree requirements in the fall semester will participate in the December commencement ceremony; spring semester will participate in the May commencement ceremony; and summer sessions will participate in the commencement ceremony held in August. Students will not participate in the commencement ceremony if not all degree requirements are completed prior to the ceremony. Students not completing all requirements will participate in the next scheduled commencement ceremony, providing all degree requirements are met. Students taking courses at other institutions must have official transcripts submitted to the Registrar's Office and have completed all degree requirements in enough time for the ATU registrar to audit the students' degree prior to the commencement ceremony to be allowed to participate.


Participation in commencement is expected of all candidates for degrees. Students who are unable to participate may officially petition the Vice President for Academic Affairs in writing for permission to have the degree awarded in absentia.

Students who do not have a minimum grade point of 2.00 in the major and overall will not be eligible to participate in the commencement ceremony.

All graduates shall wear academic Regalia during the graduation ceremony. The academic regalia consist only of the cap and gown. Students may wear honor cords, pins, or stoles representative of university groups over their gown during the ceremony. Decoration on caps is permitted.


